

Table 1. WBCT Institutional Criteria

1- Mechanism of Injury
• Motor Vehicle Accidents: • Prolonged extrication • Ejection • Pedestrian hit by vehicle • Motorcycle accident • Falls: > 3 meters* or of unknow height • Explosion
2- Injuries Noticed on Primary Survey
• Two or more body zones injured • Two or more proximal long-bone fractures • Major pelvic injury • Proximal amputation • Signs of spinal cord injury
3- Vital signs
• Intubated patient with initial GCS* < 9 • Altered mental status: GCS* <12 • Suspected alcohol and/or drugs • Systolic blood pressure < 100 mmHg • Respiratory rate: < 10 or > 30 per minute • Heart rate: > 120 beats per minute

- Age over 65
- Use of anticoagulants

*3 meters = 9.8 ft; *GCS: Glasgow Coma Scale
