58.7% of medical students reported the high cost of subscription of online resources as a barrier to accessing these digital resources. 62.% of Federal university students reported this.

Poor internet access was viewed as a barrier to online resources by 55% of medical students, with 65.8% of students in private universities reporting this as a barrier.

Lack of Institutional Provision played a role in preventing 53.8% of medical students across institution type from accessing digital academic tools and resources.

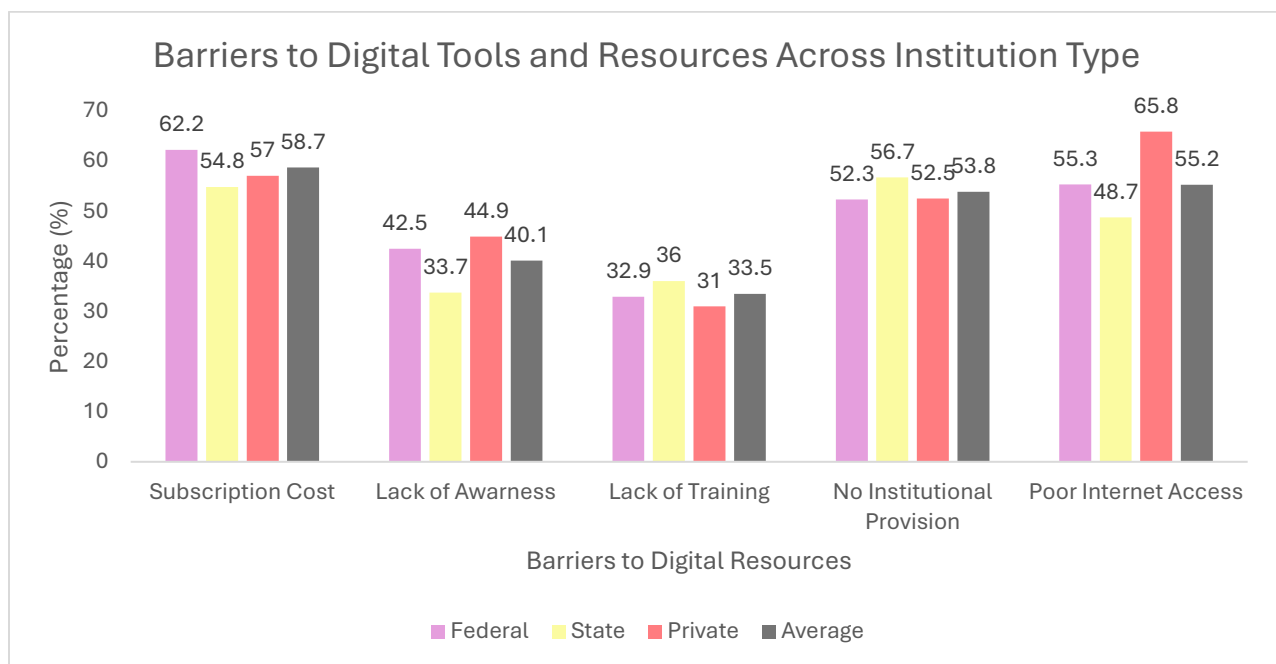


Figure 1. Composite Bar Chart Showing the Percentage Distribution of Barriers to Accessing Digital Academic Tools and Resources Faced by Medical Students Based on their Type of Institution.
