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**Figure Title:** The effect of intercropping fava bean with winter wheat on the soil nutrient and C cycles.

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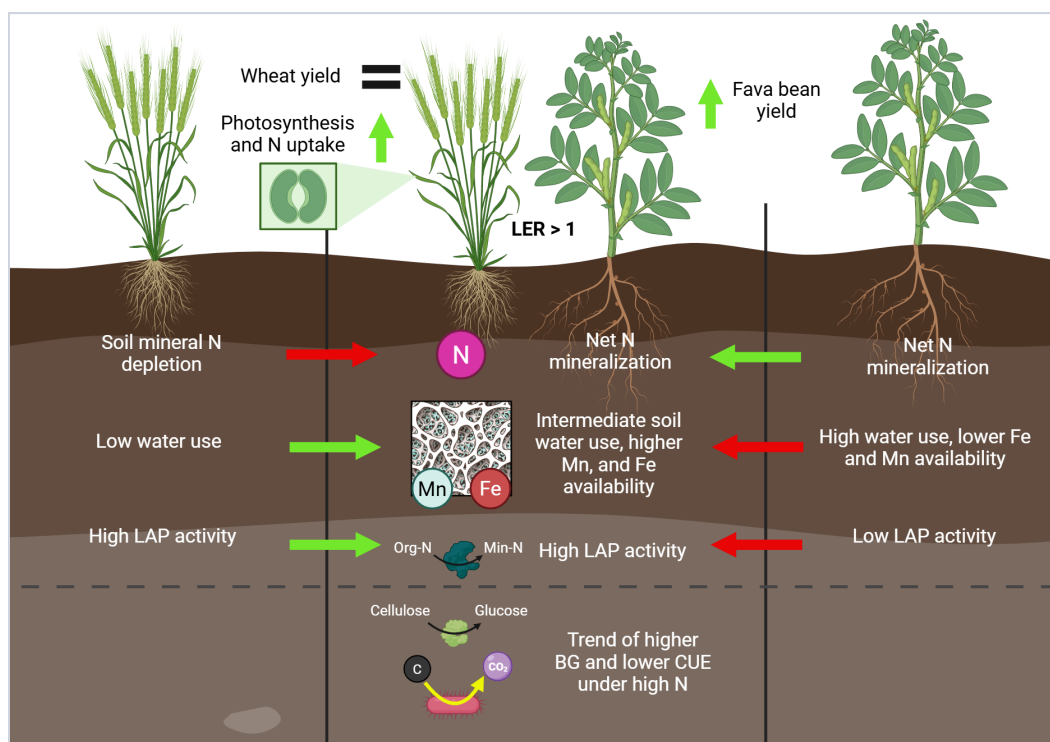
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
