2. Which programs or interventions have been implemented as part of Tomohon City's Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program?
3. What efforts have been made to ensure the program's successful implementation in Tomohon City? Please describe the program's strengths and weaknesses, aspects requiring improvement, and how those improvements should be undertaken.
4. Which individuals, institutions, or sectors should be involved in implementing the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program in Tomohon City?
5. What commitments have been made to support the implementation of the program in Tomohon City? How have these commitments been operationalized? Have there been any barriers to fulfilling these goals?
6. Is an evaluation model currently used to assess the implementation of the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program in Tomohon City? If so, please describe the model and how it was applied.
7. How do stakeholders use evaluation findings? Does the evaluation help stakeholders explain the implementation and performance of the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program?
8. Are there any challenges in evaluating the program's implementation in Tomohon City? If so, how have these challenges been addressed?
9. What recommendations would you propose to improve the evaluation of the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program, including the possible use of a digital system?

C. Input Component

1. Are the resources used to implement the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program adequate? Please consider the following points:
 - a. Human resources: Is the available workforce adequate for program implementation?

 3. What are the sources of these resources, including human resources, infrastructure and facilities, funding and partners? What are the costs of infrastructure and facilities, or how much funding has been allocated to them?
 4. Which individuals, institutions, or sectors are involved or collaborate to mobilize and manage the inputs required to support program implementation?
 5. What qualifications and competencies do the personnel involved in managing or providing program inputs possess?
 6. How are the resources used for program implementation evaluated
 7. To what extent is the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program monitored?

D. Process Component

1. When was the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program implemented, and what program activities were undertaken to accelerate stunting reduction?
2. What procedures, activities, or interventions are undertaken during the implementation of the program?
3. How would you assess the performance of the individuals involved in implementing this program?
4. Are the planned program activities implemented according to the schedule?
5. Do all program inputs - human resources, infrastructure and facilities, funding, and partners - adequately support the implementation process?
6. What weaknesses or limitations have been identified in the program implementation?
7. What strategies are used to implement interventions in the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program?
8. What innovations have been introduced in the implementation of the program interventions?
9. Have intervention plans been modified when the planned interventions were not implemented? If so, please explain the changes.
10. What actions do the human resources involved in the program undertake to achieve the intended results?
11. Who participates in or is reached by the program? What is the extent of the program's coverage or reach?
12. Do program managers and implementers demonstrate adherence to established program procedures and requirements?
13. Is the community involved in supporting this program? Have community-based groups or structures been established to support it?
14. How is the program implementation process evaluated?
15. Is any technology used to support the evaluation of program implementation? If so, please describe.

E. Output Component

1. To what extent have the objectives of the Accelerated Stunting Reduction Program been achieved?

2. Which program activities have achieved relatively high results and which have achieved relatively low results?
3. What is the level of satisfaction among individuals or groups targeted by the program?
4. Are the services provided by program managers appropriate and accurately targeted at the intended beneficiaries?
5. Have the program activities and intended outputs been completed on time
6. What positive and negative impacts have resulted from the implementation of the program?
7. Should the program be continued without changes, continued with revisions, or discontinued? Please explain the reasons for your assessment.
8. How are program outputs evaluated? Have improvements in nutritional status been achieved, and have the expected program quality standards been met?
