



Bull Cave

Pang Mapha District,
Mae Hong Son Province,
Thailand

Bull Cave contains ceramic and bronze artifacts in two caches (see Mid-Level Offset and North Profile) that date from the early 1st millennium. One bronze spatula has a finial in the shape of a zebu type bull, as illustrated above (Peter Grave, 2026).

The cave was rediscovered by William Fanning (USA) in the early 1990s.

This map was completed February 22, 2026, using data from Disto-X2 surveys conducted by the 2026 American Expedition to Thailand on January 14, 15, and 21, 2026.

Length: 161.9 meters; depth: 24 meters
