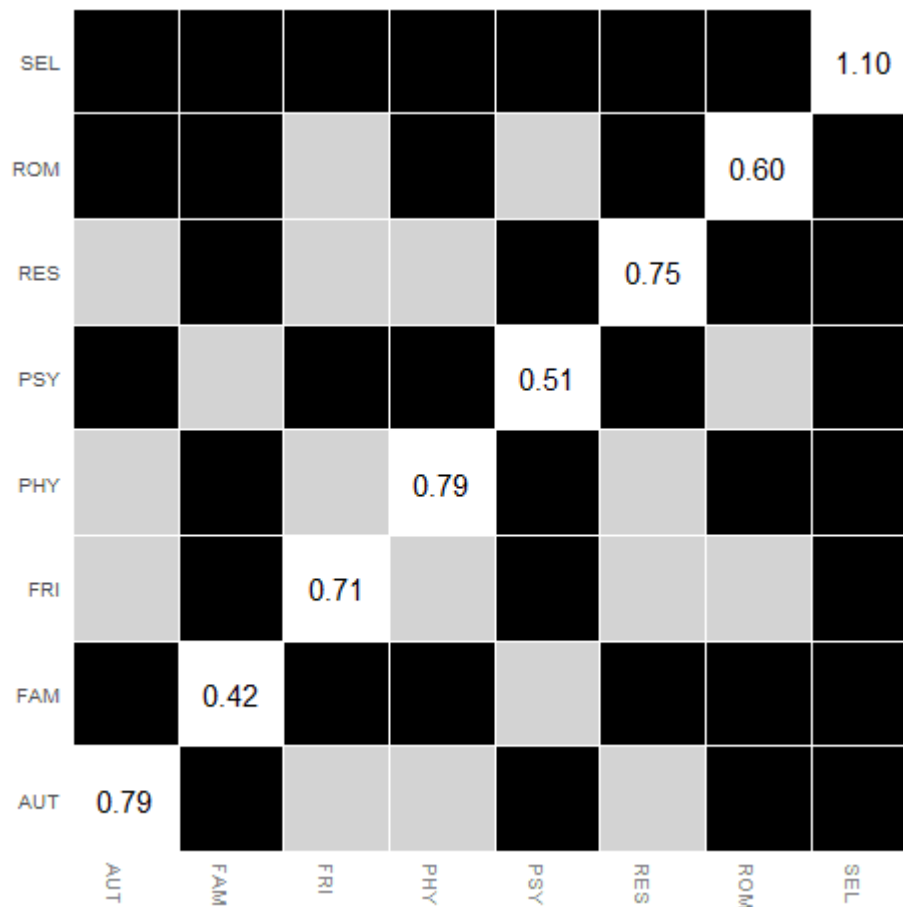


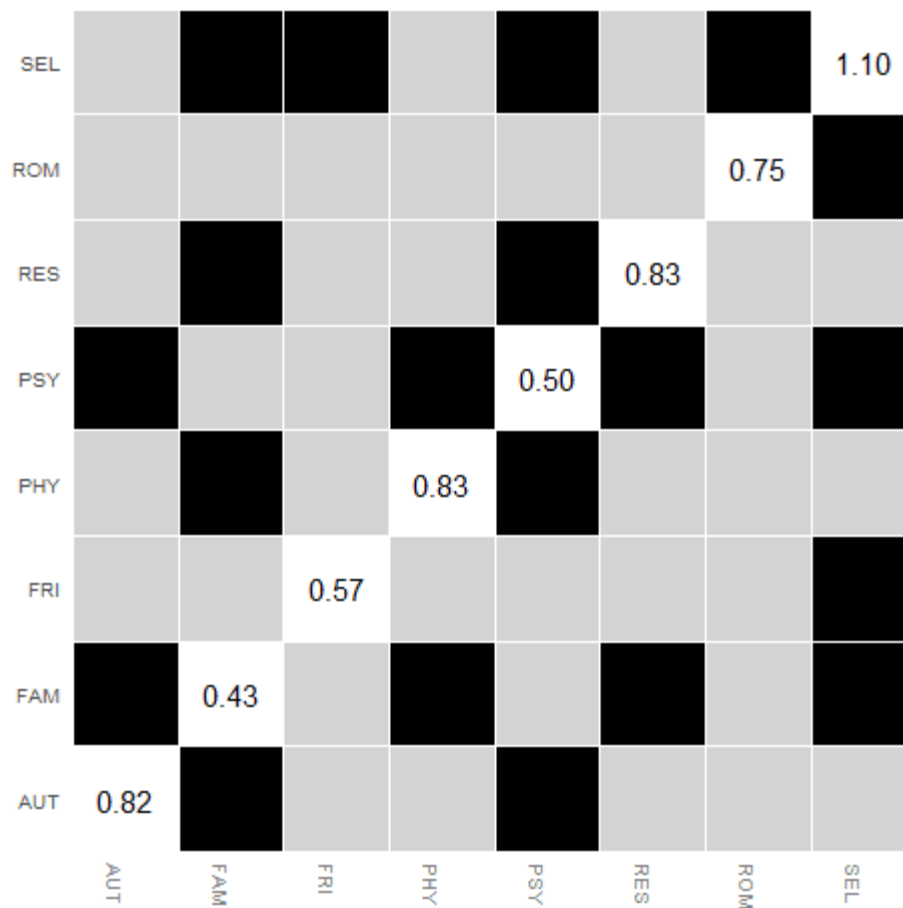
Supplementary Materials 5. Bootstrapped difference tests ($\alpha = 0.05$) between node strength for the eight quality-of-life dimensions.

A- Schizophrenia Spectrum Disorders (N=929)



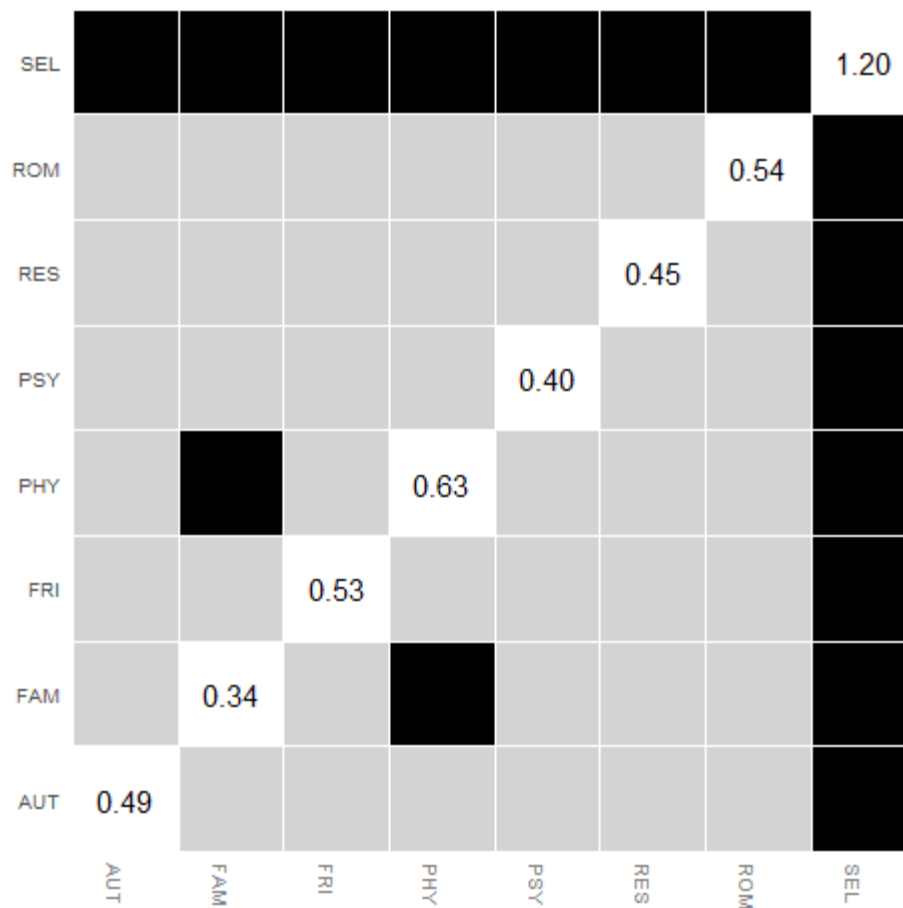

B- Neurodevelopmental Disorders (N=216)



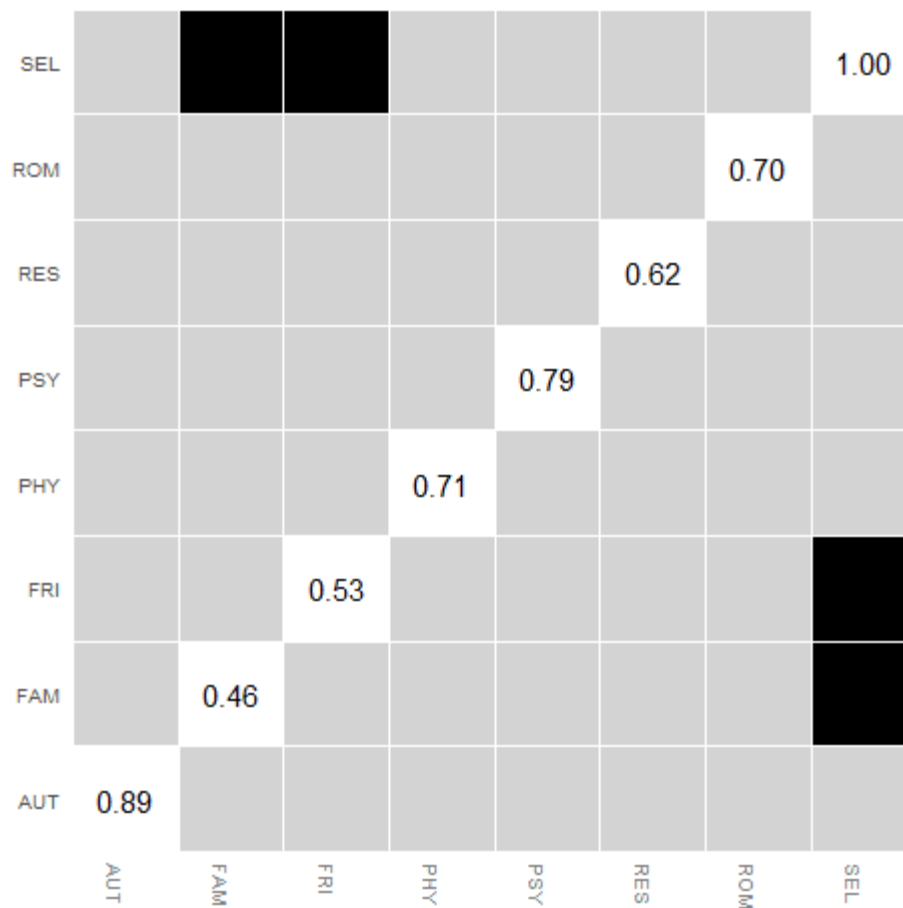

C- Bipolar Disorders (N=275)



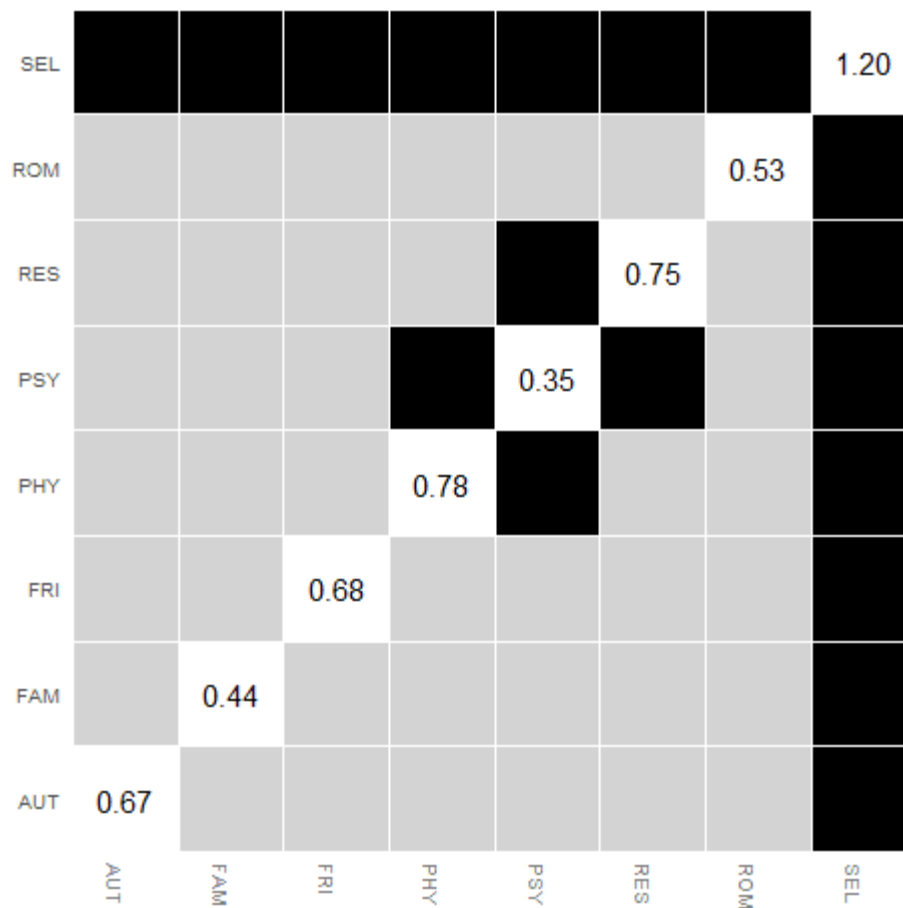

D- Depressive Disorders (N=133)



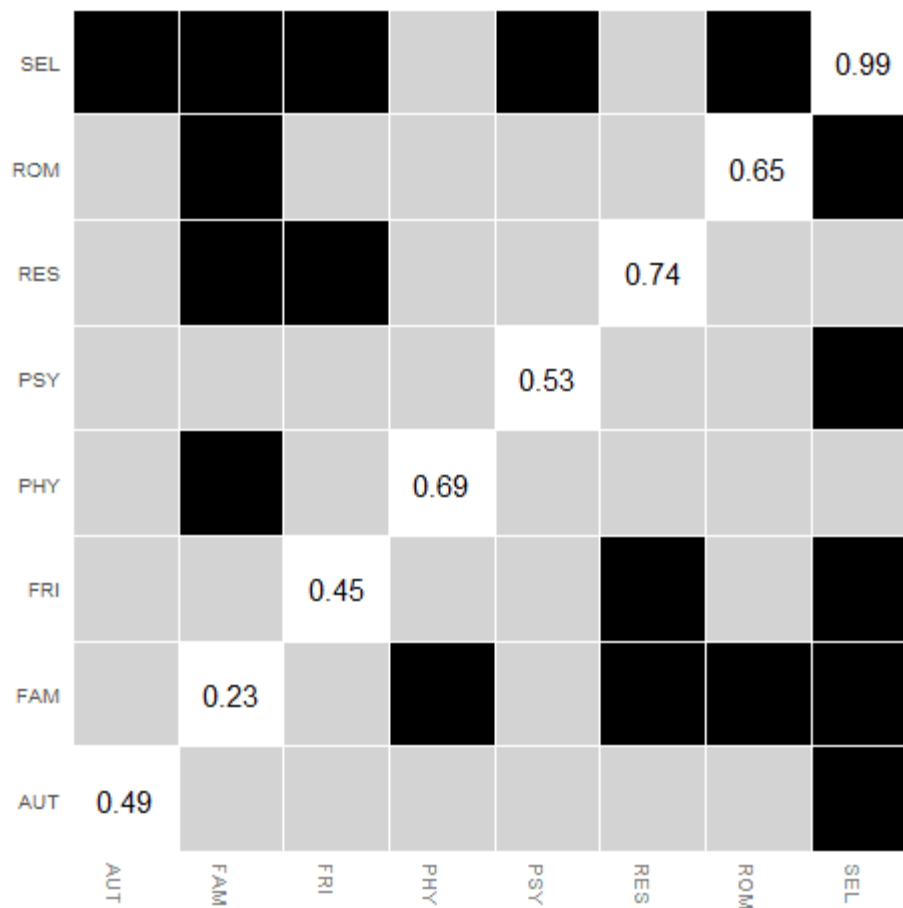
