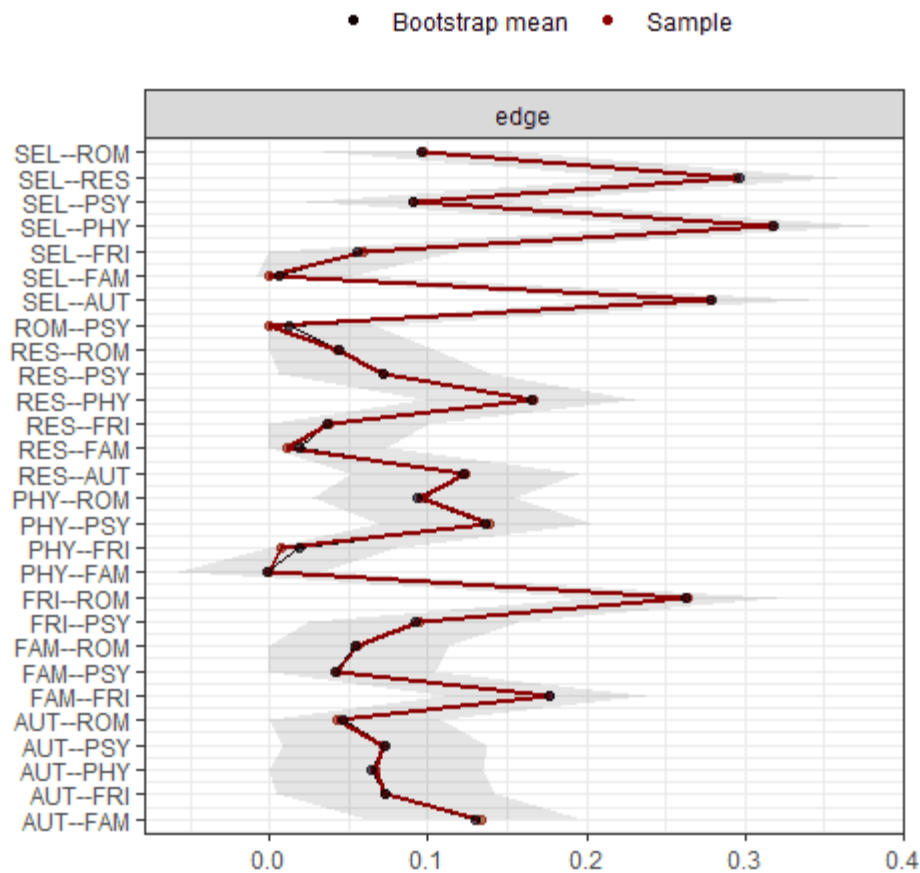


Supplementary Materials 2. Bootstrapped confidence intervals of estimated edge-weights for each estimated network

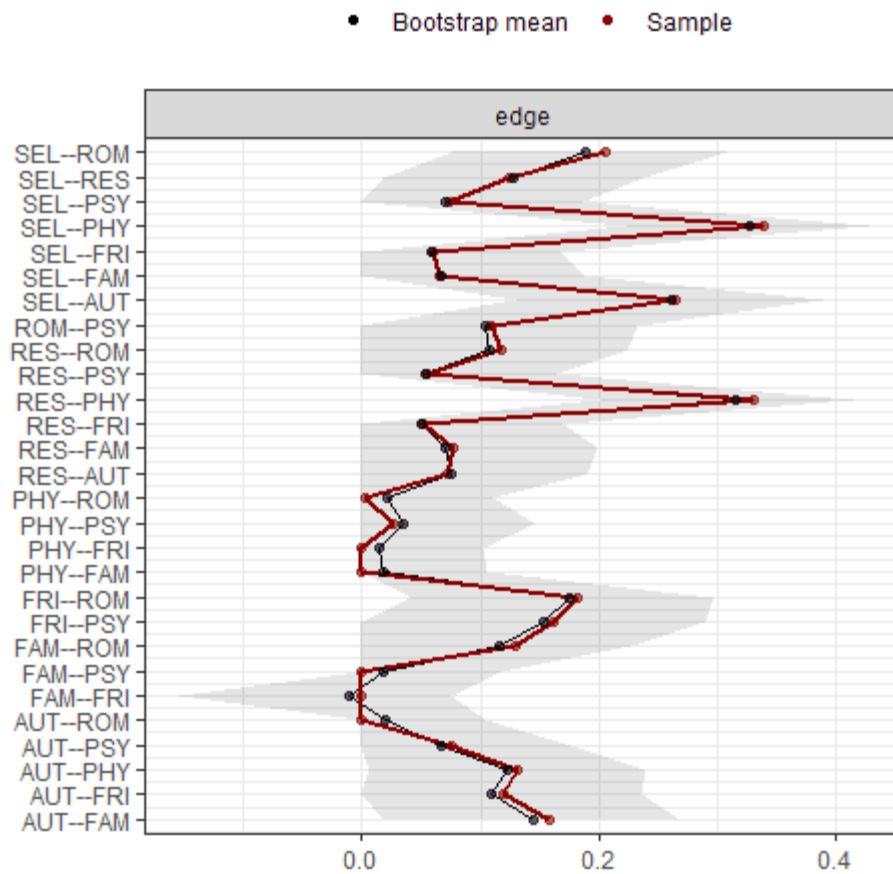
A- Schizophrenia Spectrum Disorders (N=929)



The red line indicates the sample values and the grey area the bootstrapped CIs. Each horizontal line represents one edge of the network, ordered by names.

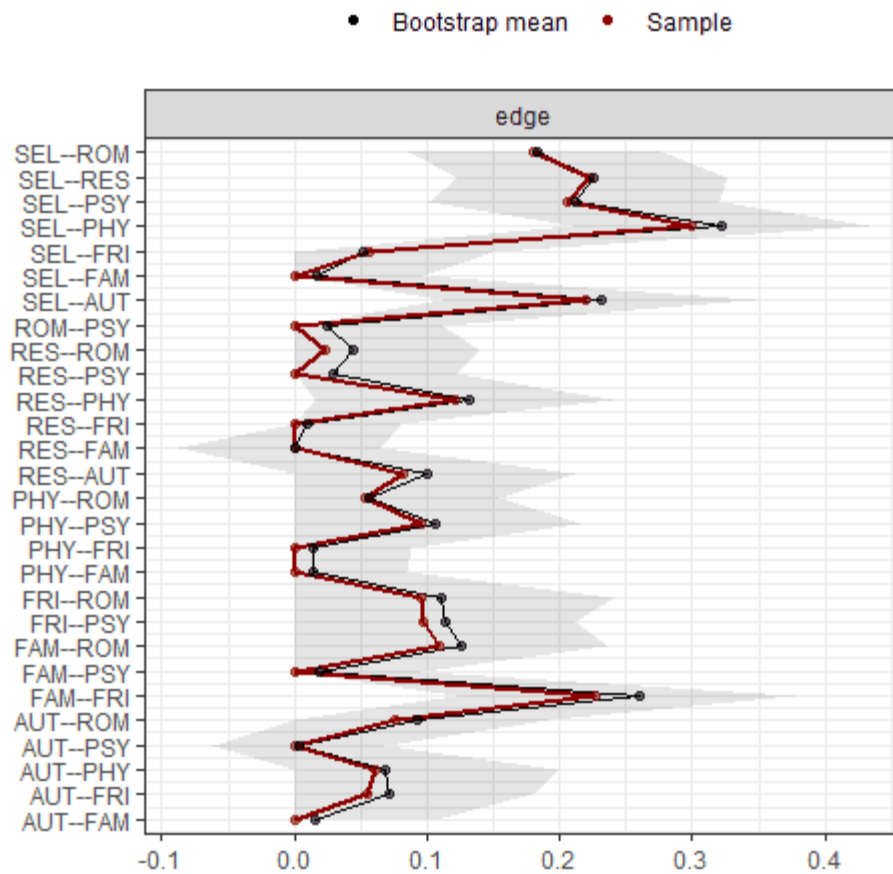

B- Neurodevelopmental Disorders (N=216)



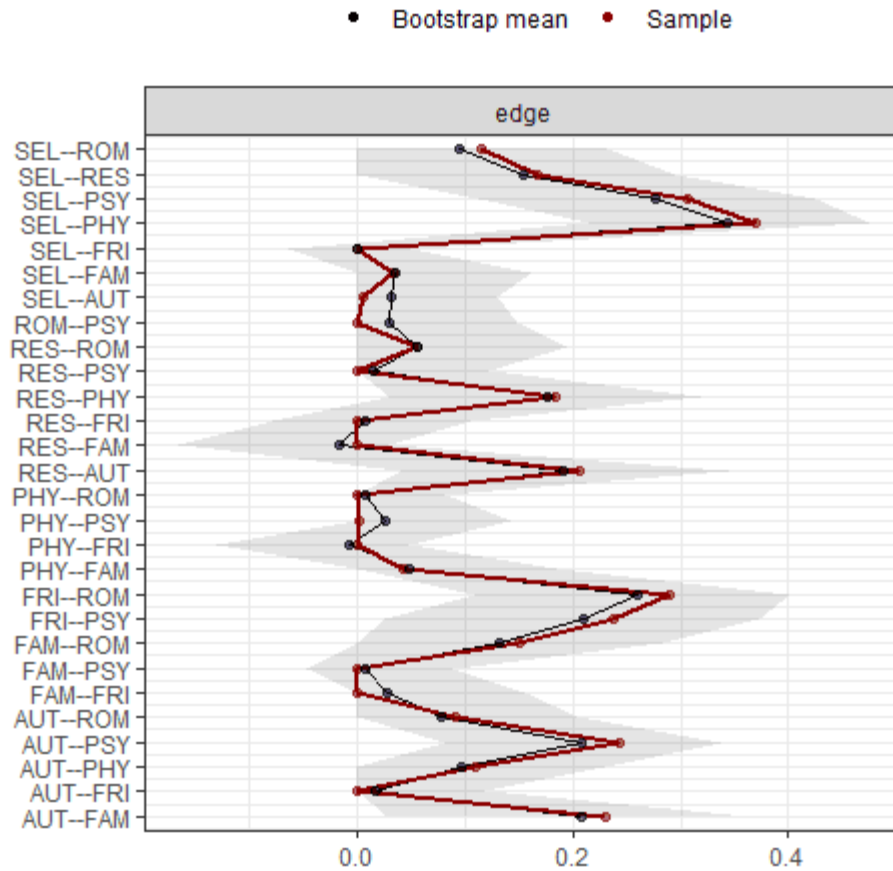

C- Bipolar Disorders (N=275)



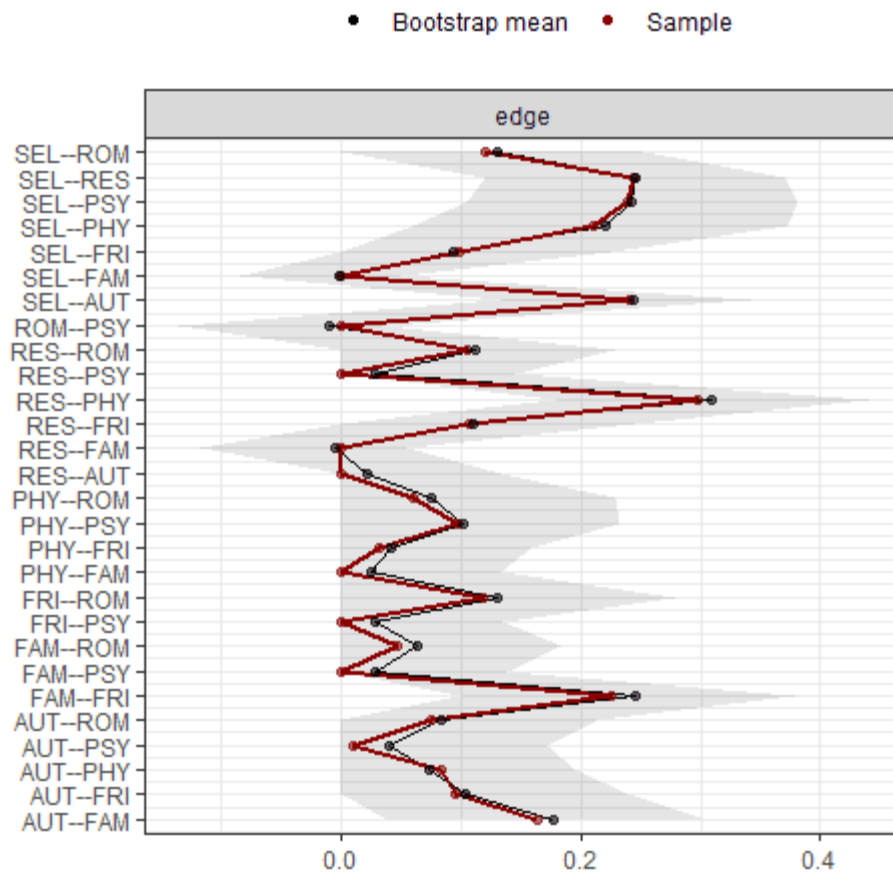

D- Depressive Disorders (N=133)



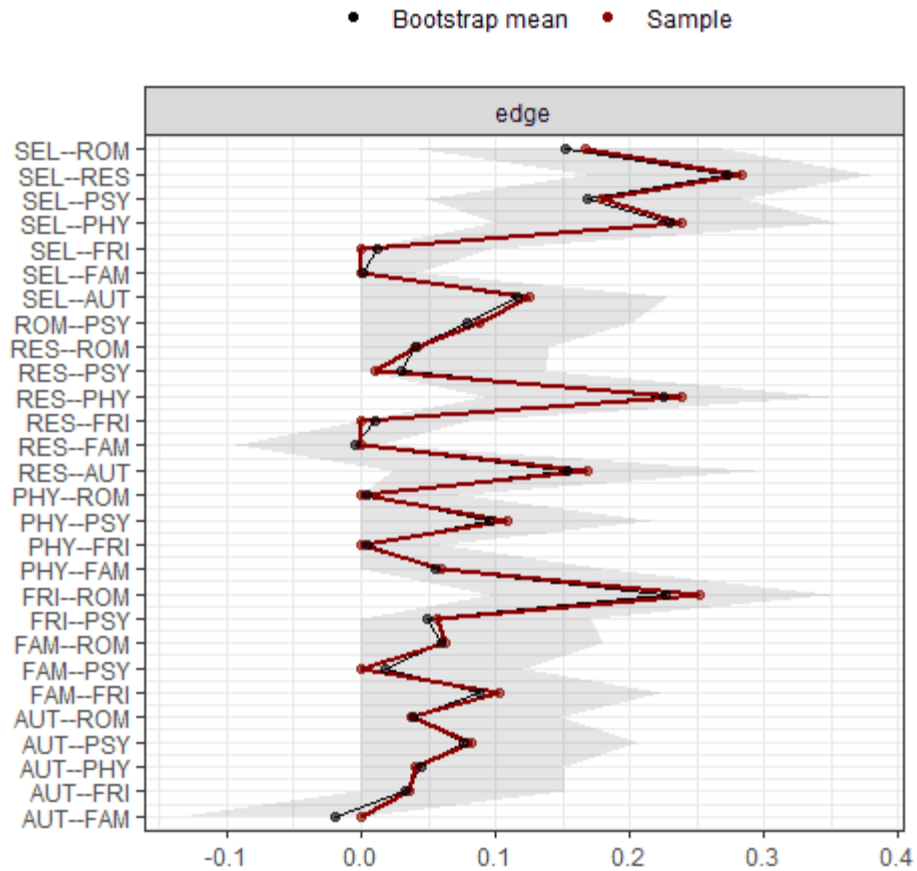
