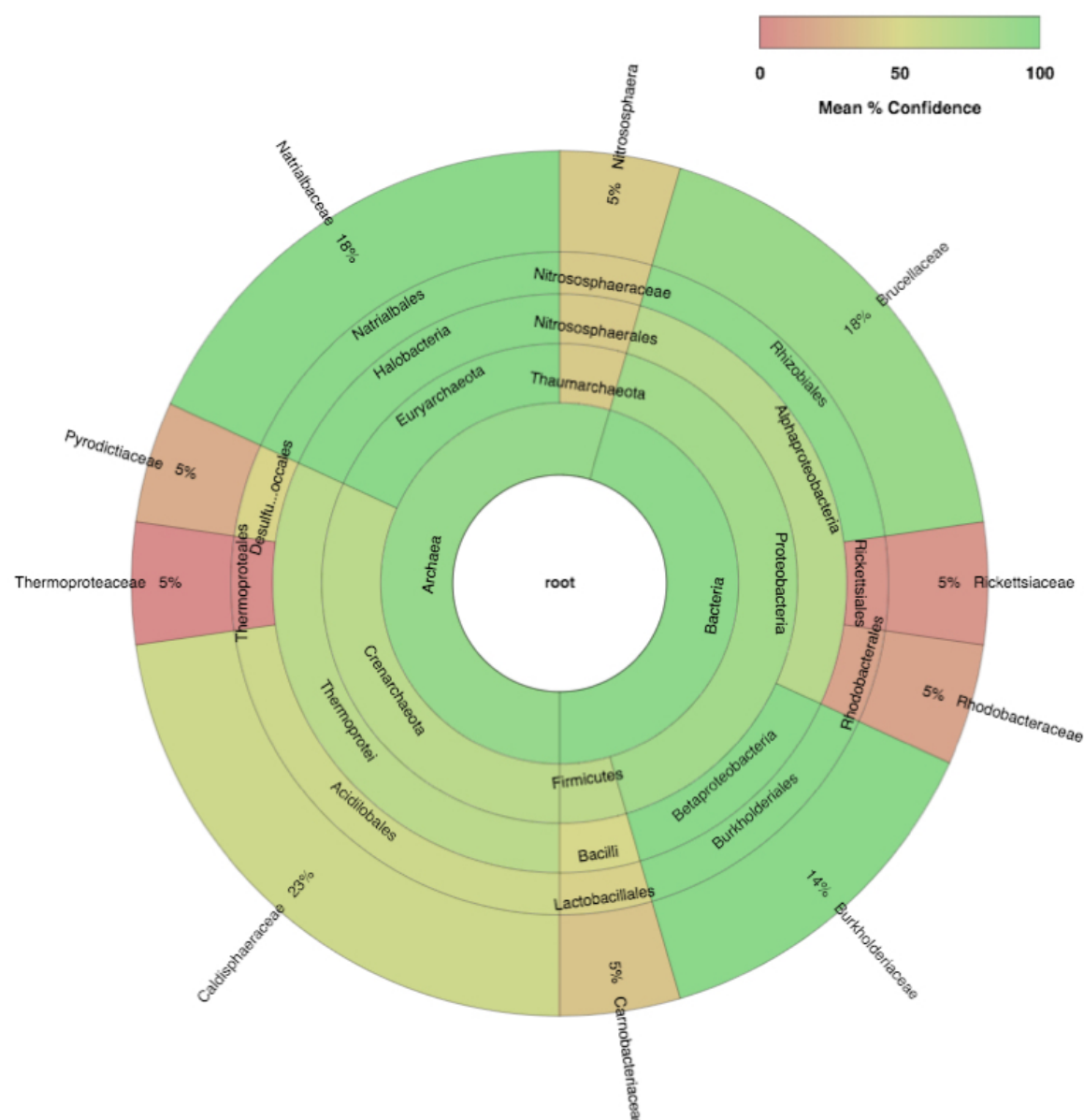
Archaea, the unseen kingdom in the gut microbiome of *Anastrepha obliqua*

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Online Resource 5 Biodiversity of Archaea communities associated at the intestine of *A. obliqua* based on 16S rDNA sequences. The 16S rDNA archaea clones obtained from wild and laboratory adult and larvae flies were merged and analyzed in Geneious software to 16S biodiversity. ~56% of sequences were relative to archaea and ~45% to bacteria.
