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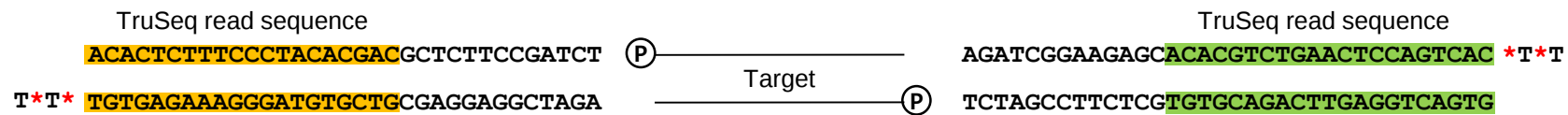
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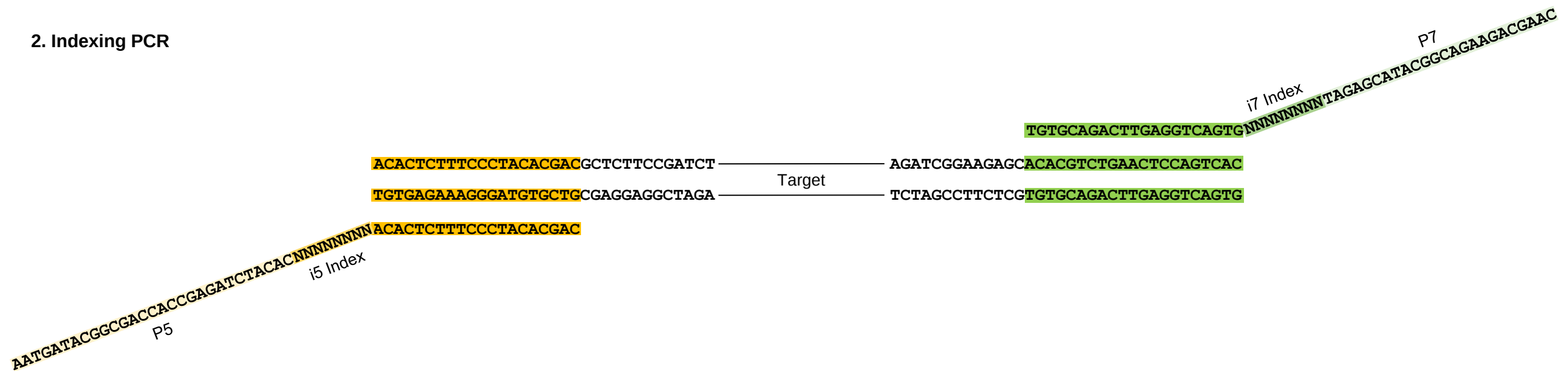
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Supplementary Fig. 1 Structure and sequence of the in-house TruSeq Compatible Universal adapter
