The grey-scale areas show the environmental suitability of Species Distribution Modelling (SDM), with intensity corresponding to the map scale. Darker areas indicate higher environmental suitability. The line involving the environmental suitability area represents the modelling Minimum Convex Polygon (MCP) and the dashed line corresponds to records MCP. The areas suitable for species establishment are in blue and Protected Areas (PAs) are in red.
