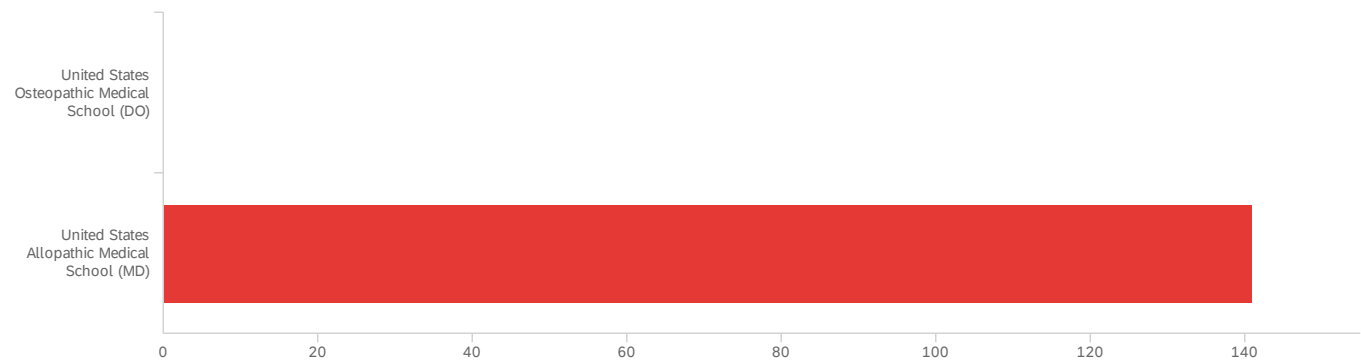

Q3 - Where do you attend medical school?



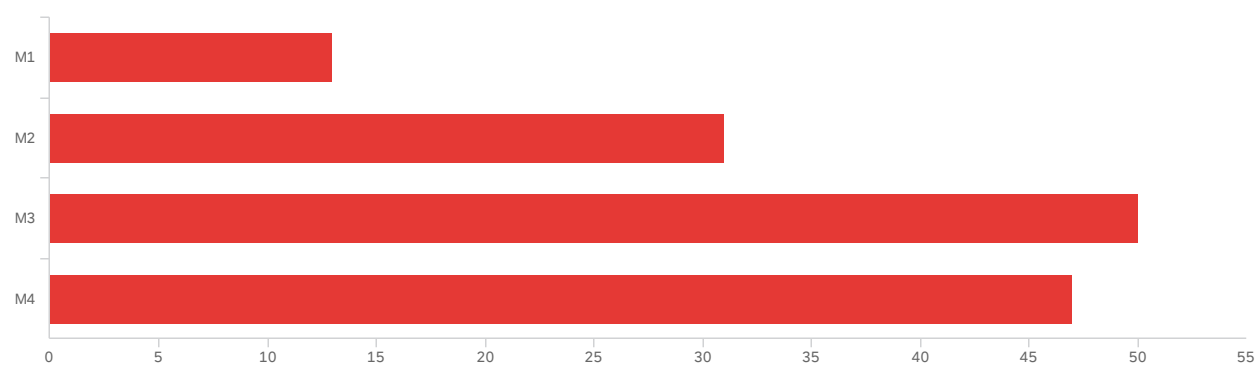

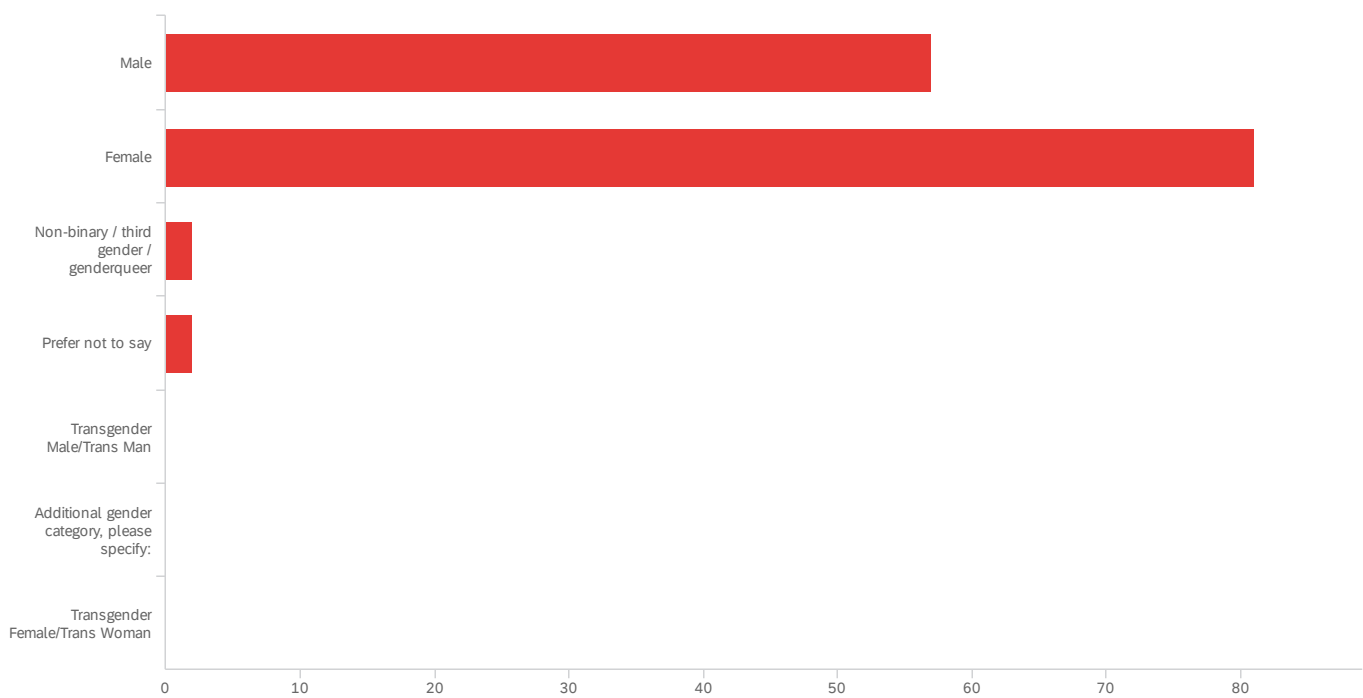

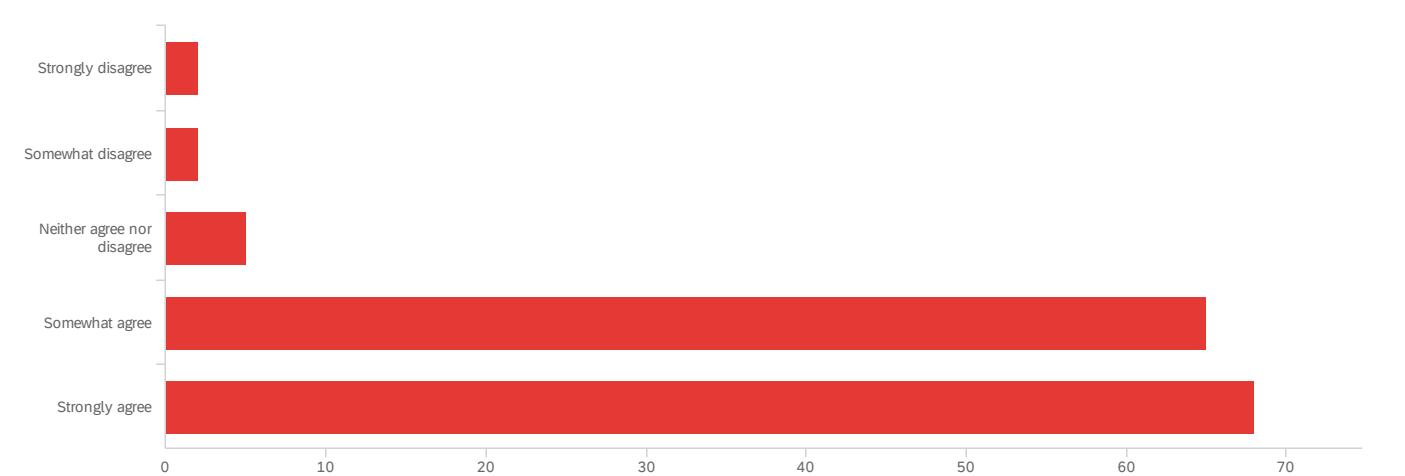

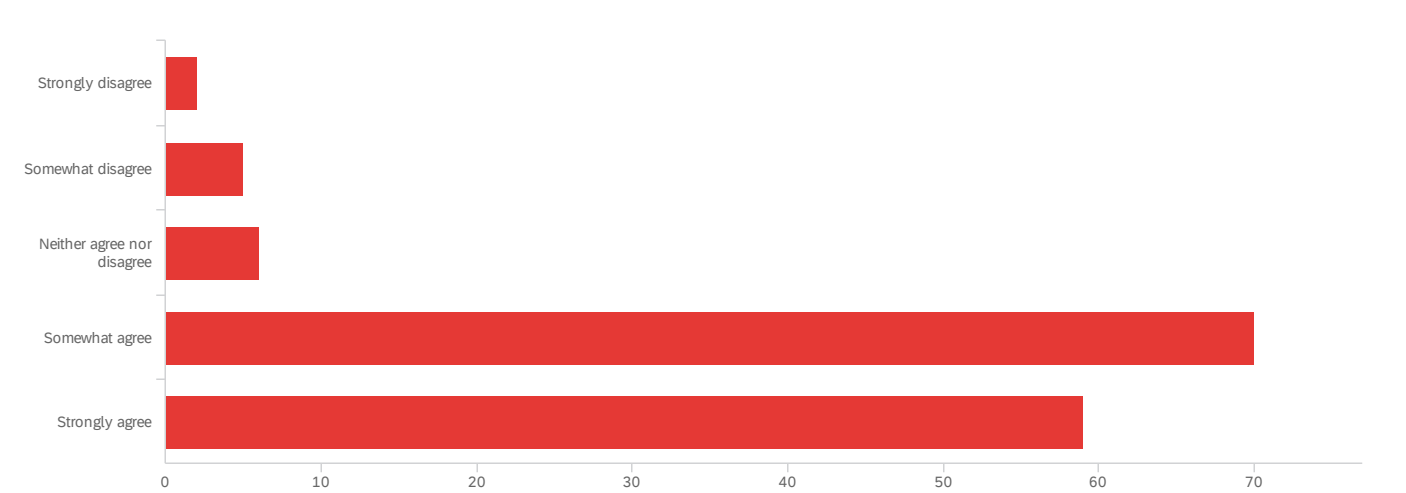

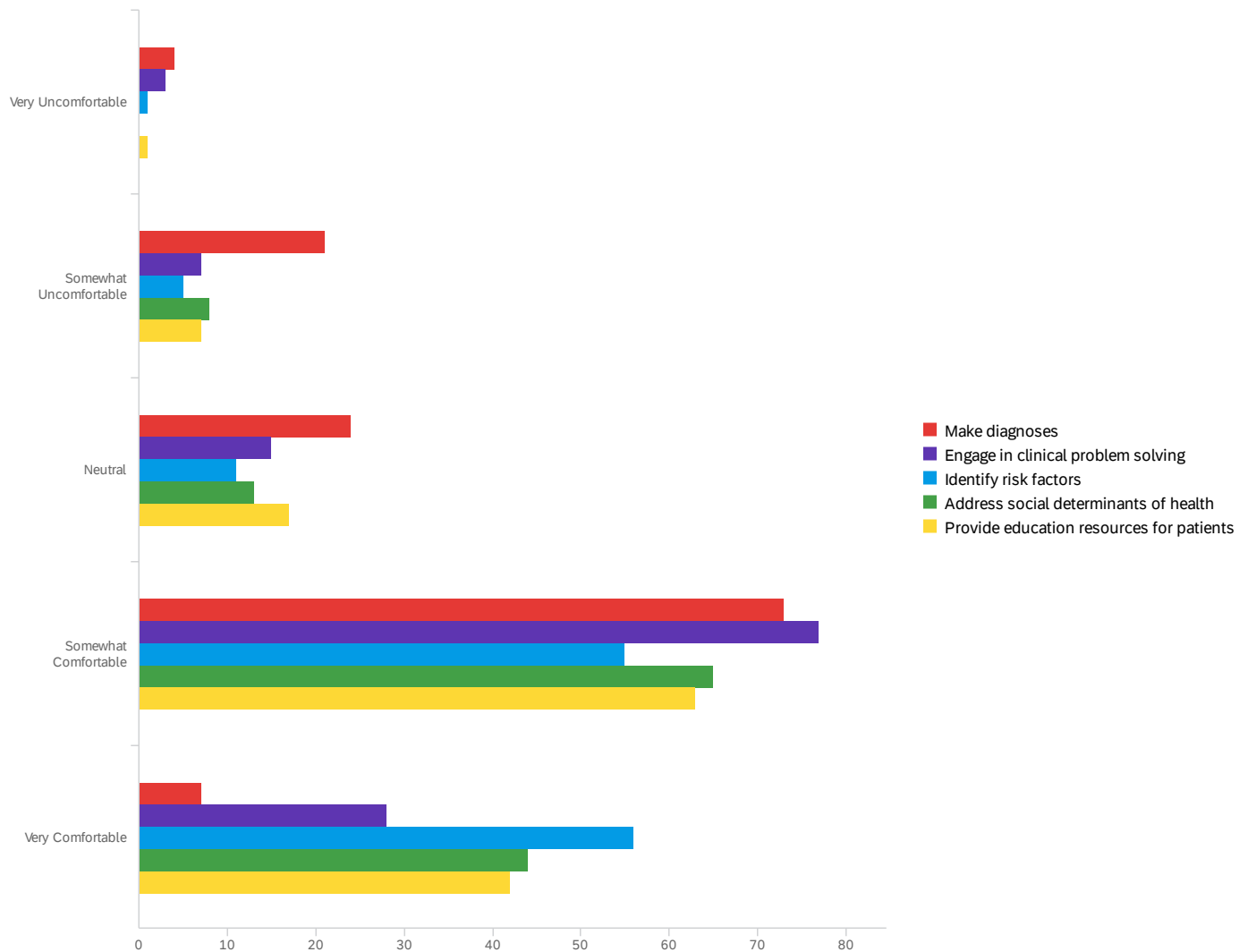

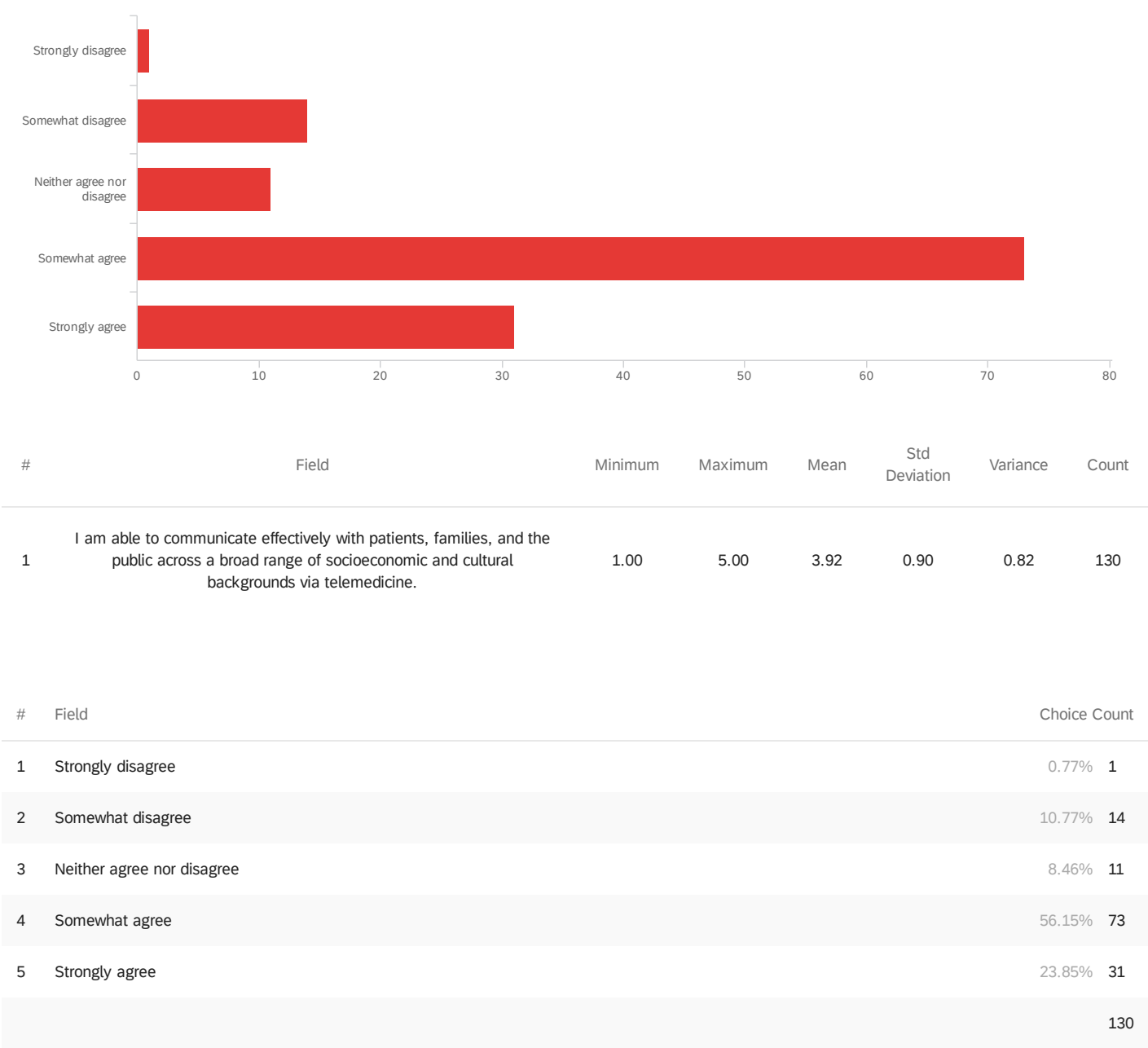

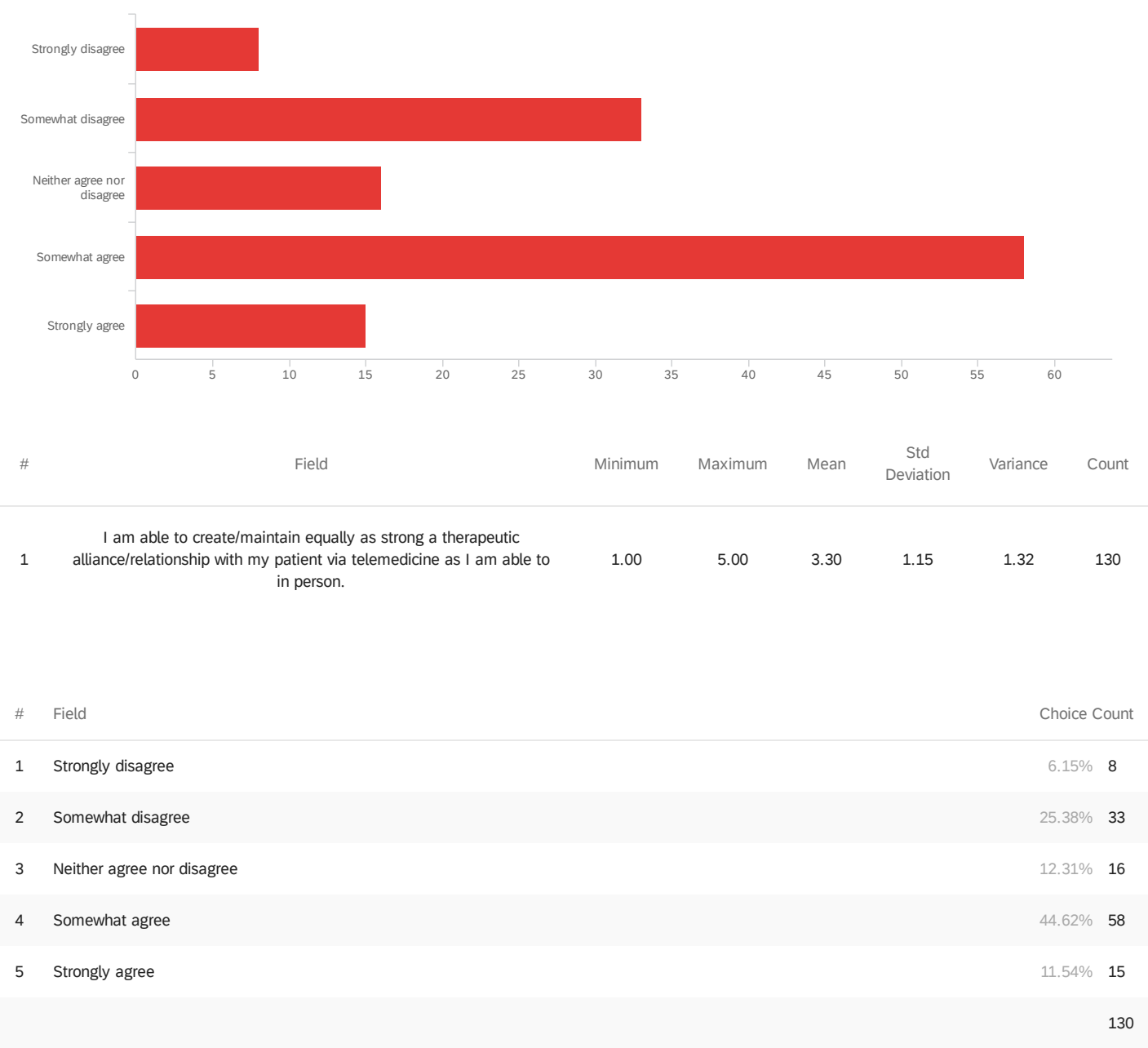

Q9 - I am able to communicate effectively with patients, families, and the public across a broad range of socioeconomic and cultural backgrounds via telemedicine.

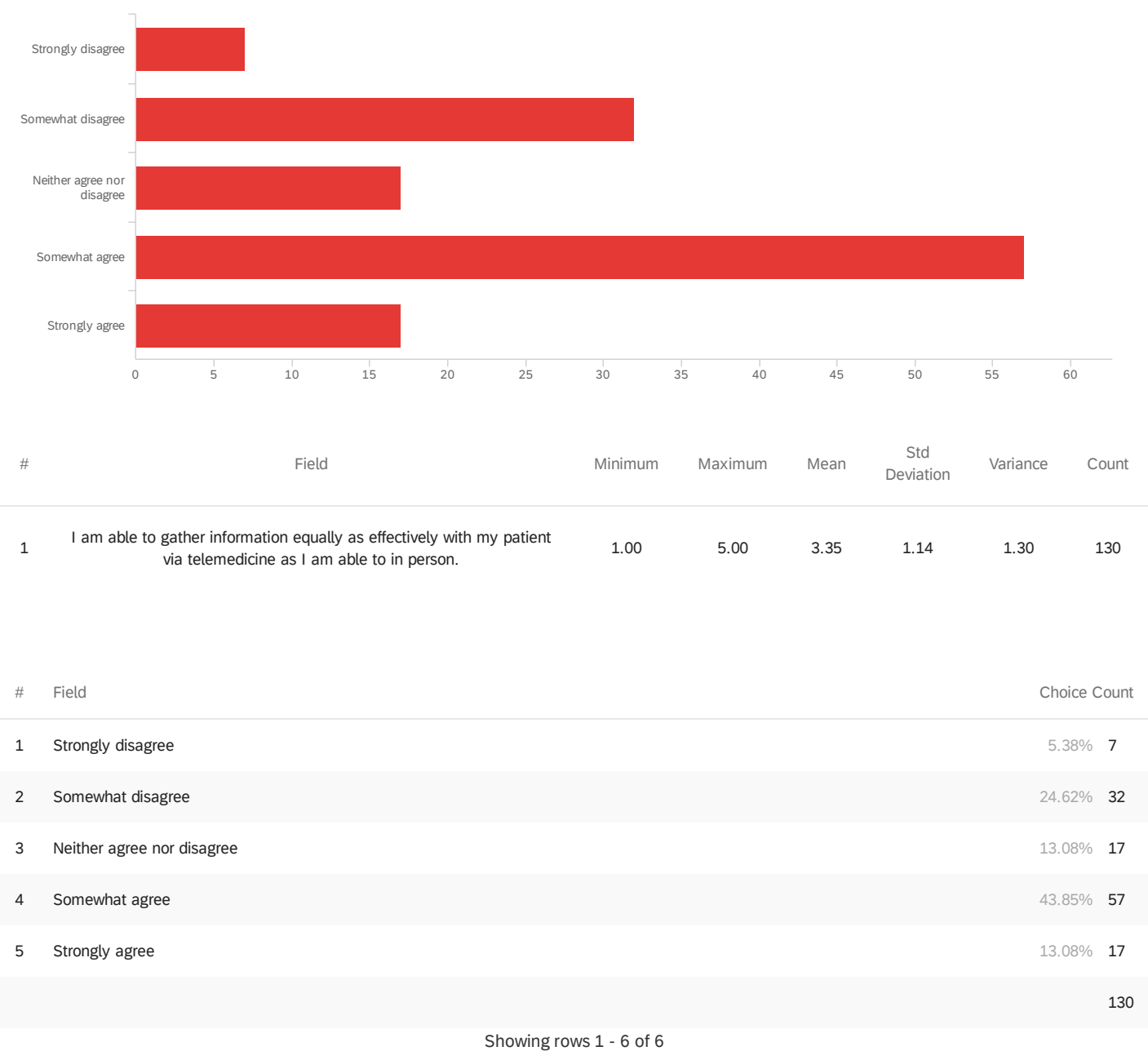

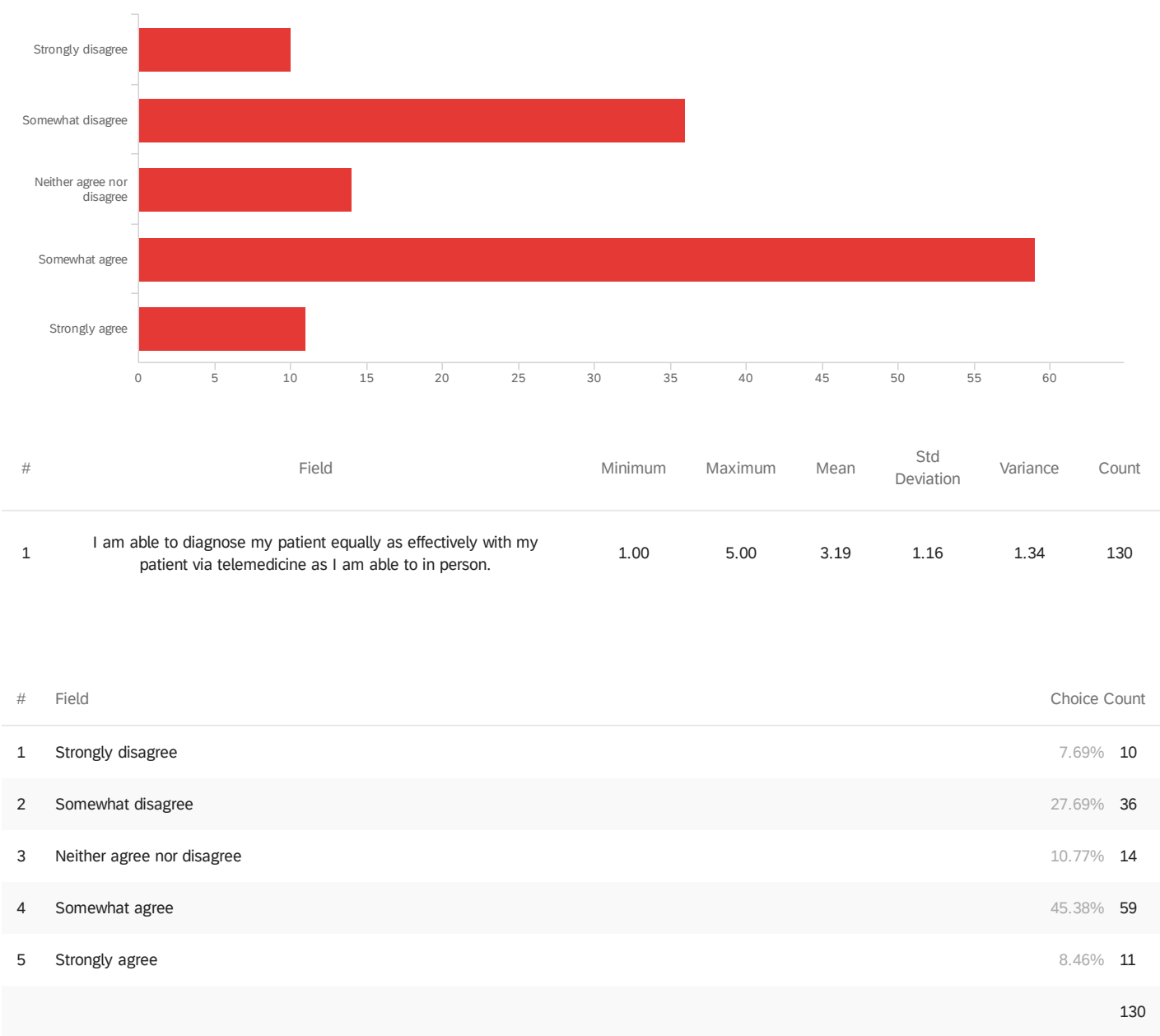
Q10 - I am able to create/maintain equally as strong a therapeutic alliance/relationship with my patient via telemedicine as I am able to in person.



Q11 - I am able to gather information equally as effectively with my patient via telemedicine as I am able to in person.

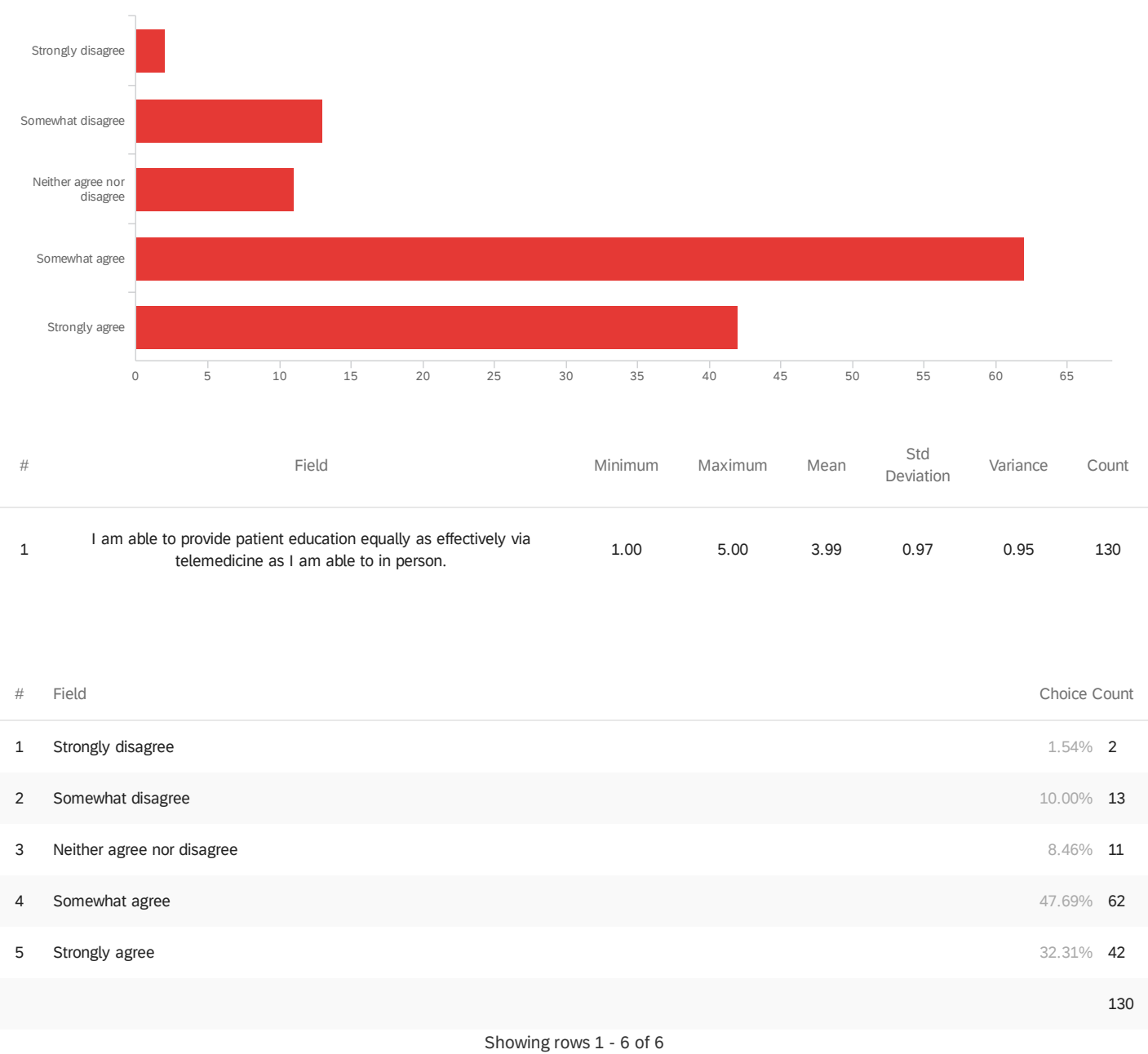


Q12 - I am able to diagnose my patient equally as effectively with my patient via telemedicine as I am able to in person.

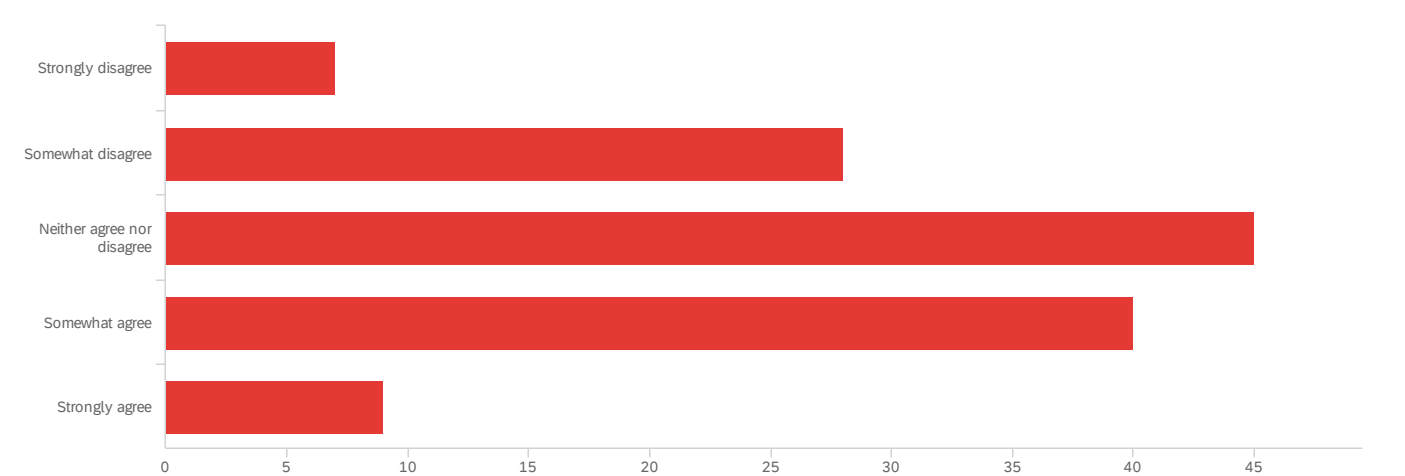

Q14 - My patient's health outcome is the same via telemedicine or in-person visits.

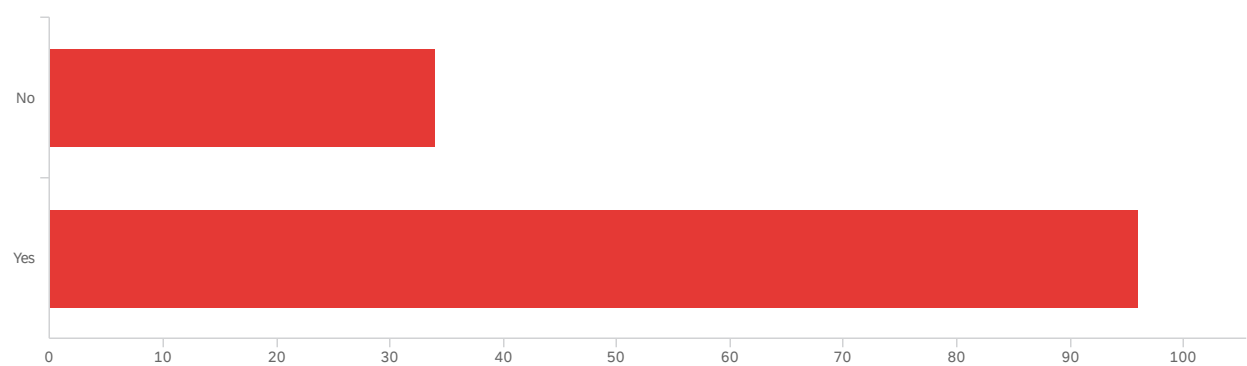

Q15 - Do you wish that telemedicine was formally taught in medical school?



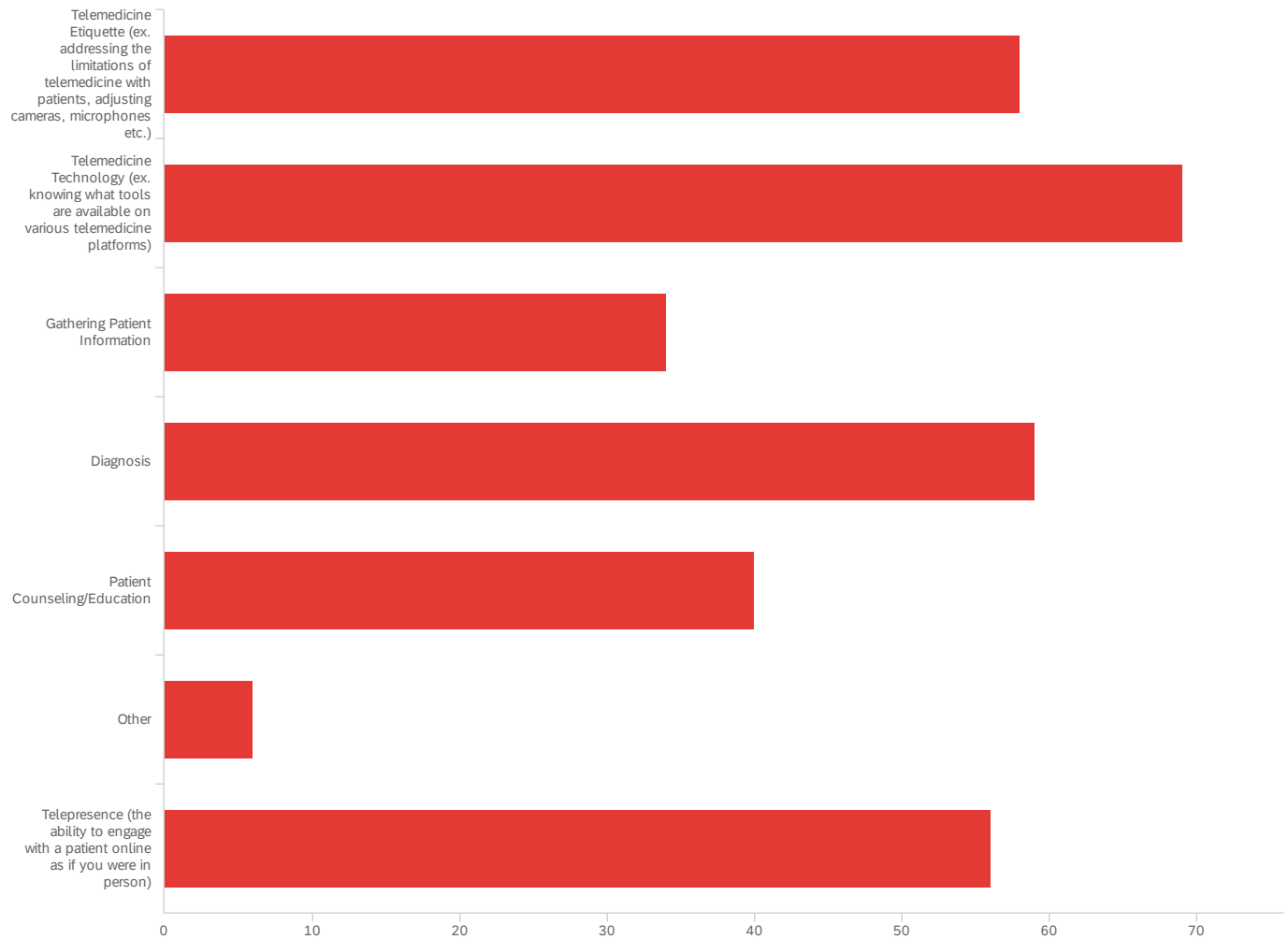
