Figure S1 – Initial conceptual framework of factors influencing maternal vaccine uptake based on relevant literature[1-10]

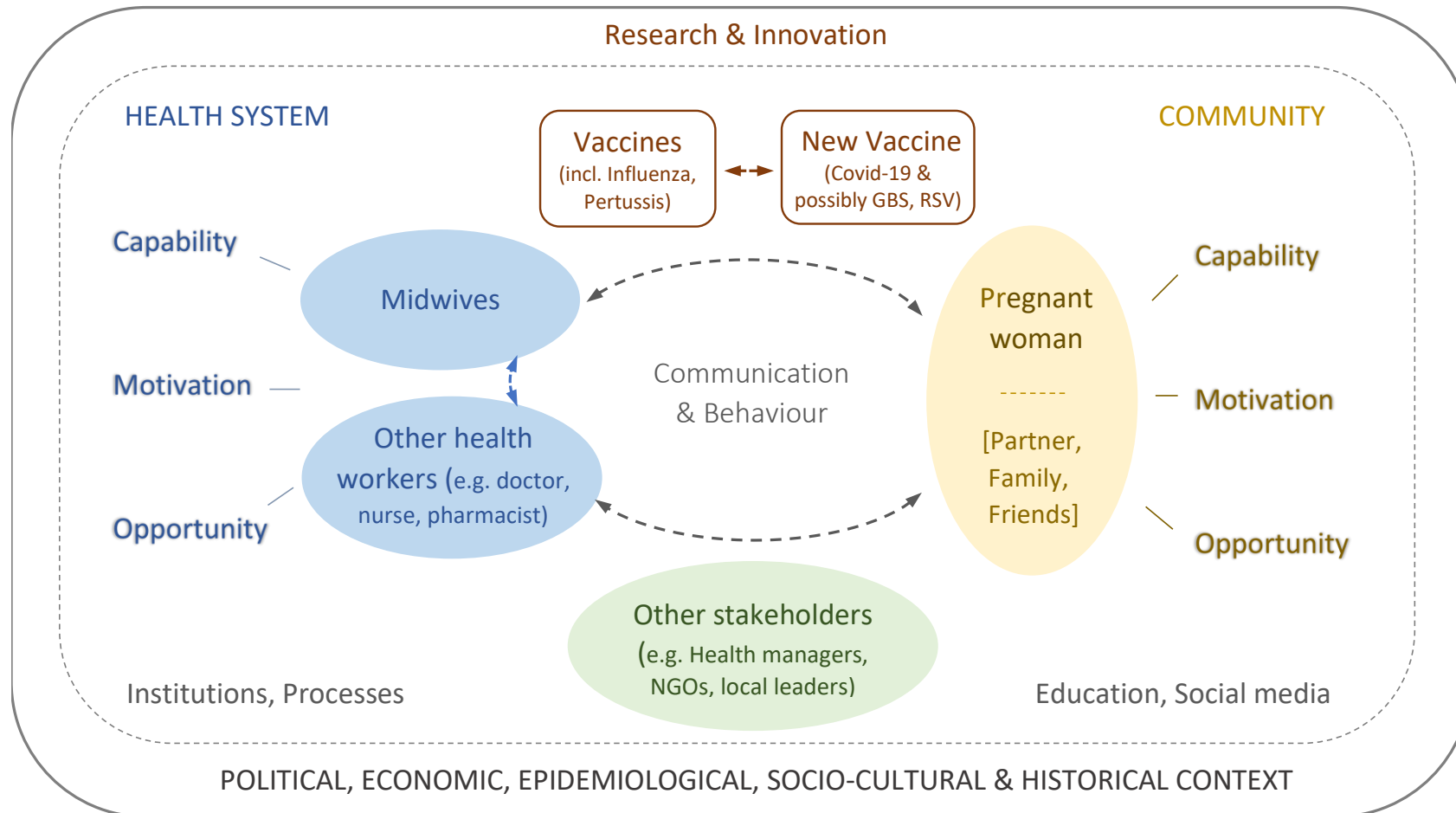
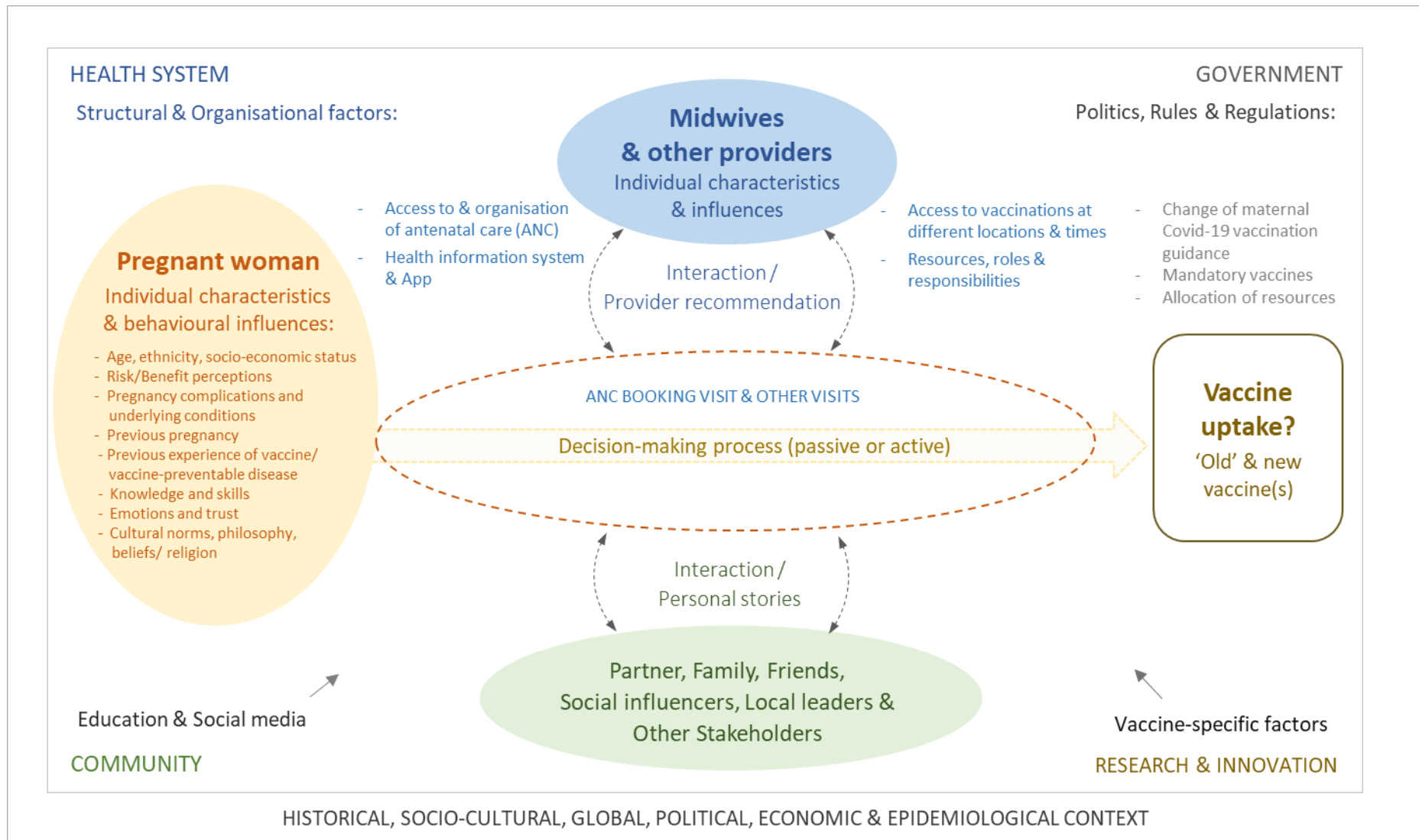


Figure S2 – Revised conceptual framework of factors influencing maternal vaccine uptake based on literature [1-10] and VIP-IDEAL study results, 2022
