Claiming your funds

You should claim your award in two portions; one claim should be submitted for a maximum of £2,000 towards the expenditure of lab consumables from the first year of your fellowship, and the latter should be for a maximum of £2,000 towards the expenditure of lab consumables from the second year of your fellowship. **All claims must be made within three months of completion of each year of research.**

To claim your awarded funds, please complete the attached offline grant claims form and return this to the [Grants Office](#) at your earliest convenience.

Here, you will be asked to note the consumable expenses you wish to claim. You must attach receipts to substantiate your claim, and you are able to add several receipts to your claim.

Please also complete the section of the form regarding bank details. Payments will be made by bank transfer, and **all claims must be made payable to a University of Glasgow bank account**. Please also ensure that you provide a reference to quote.
