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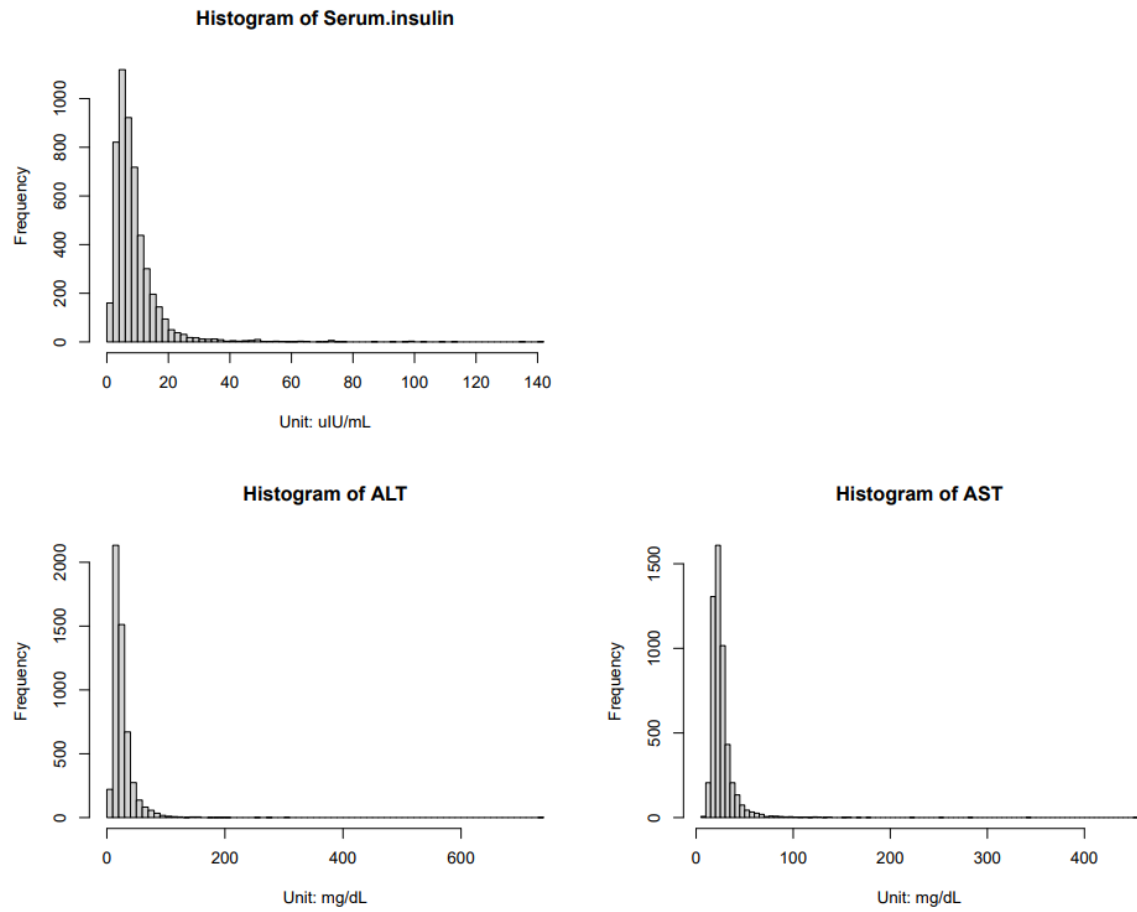
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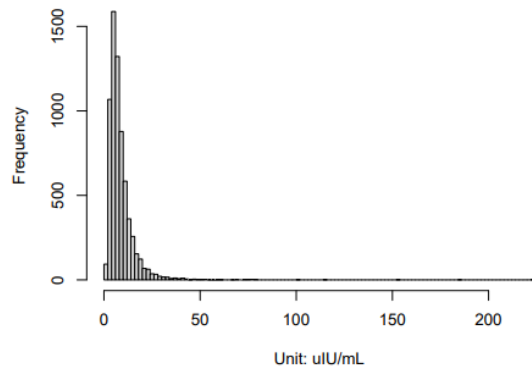
Supplementary Figure 1. Distributions of ALT, AST, ALT/AST in Korean Men (A) and women.

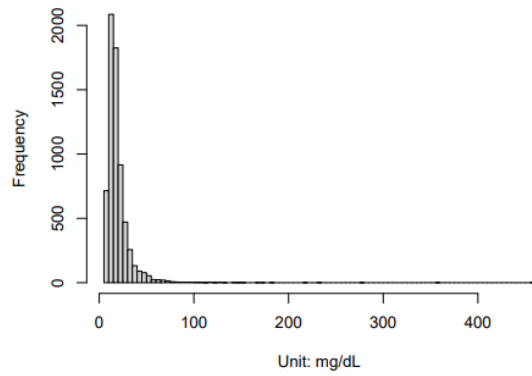
