Characterisation, activation, and reactivity of heterogenous natural clays

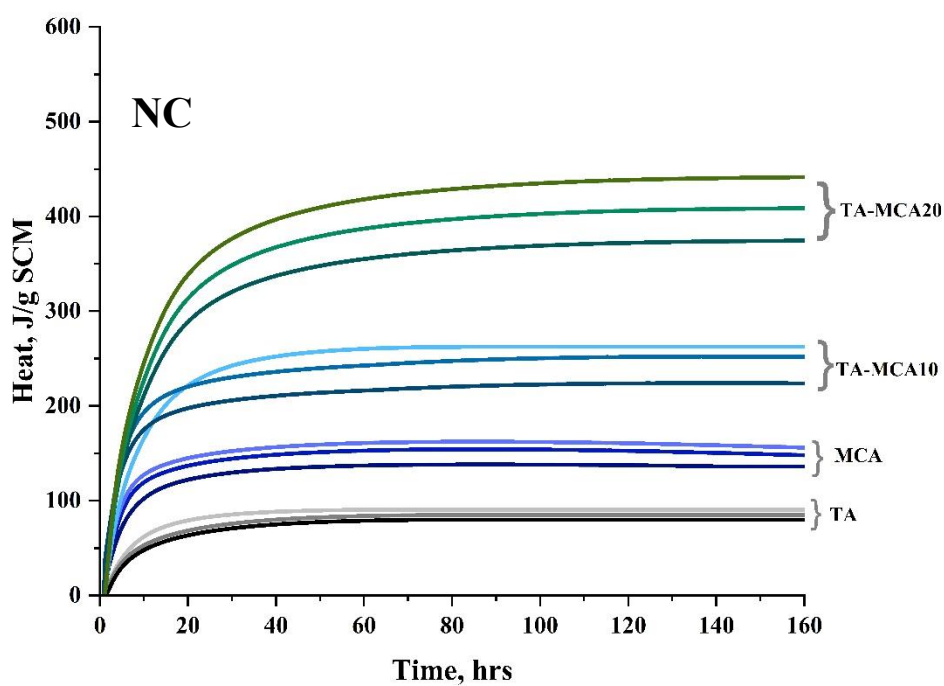
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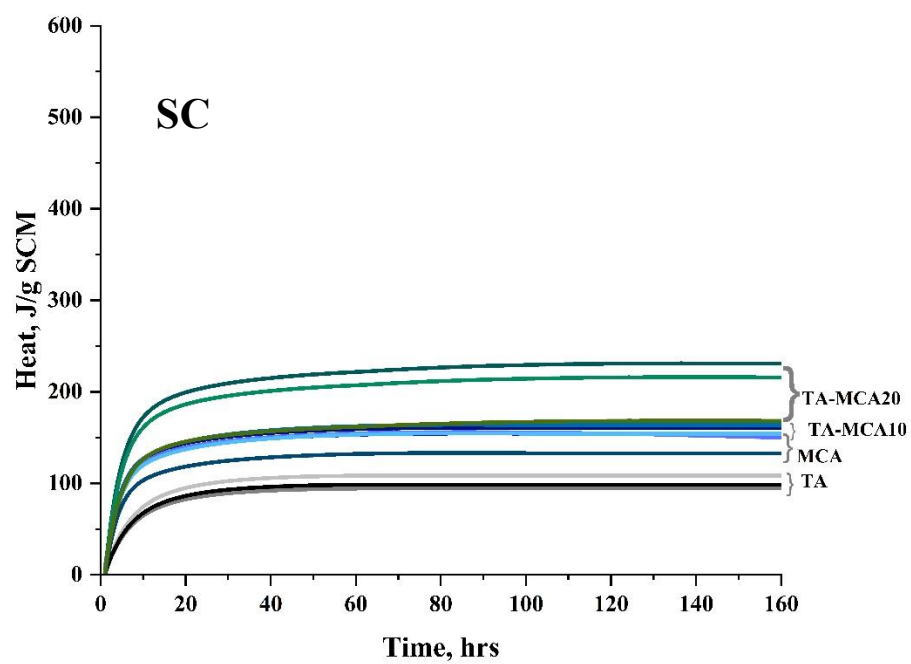
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1. R3 reactivity curves for NC and SC
