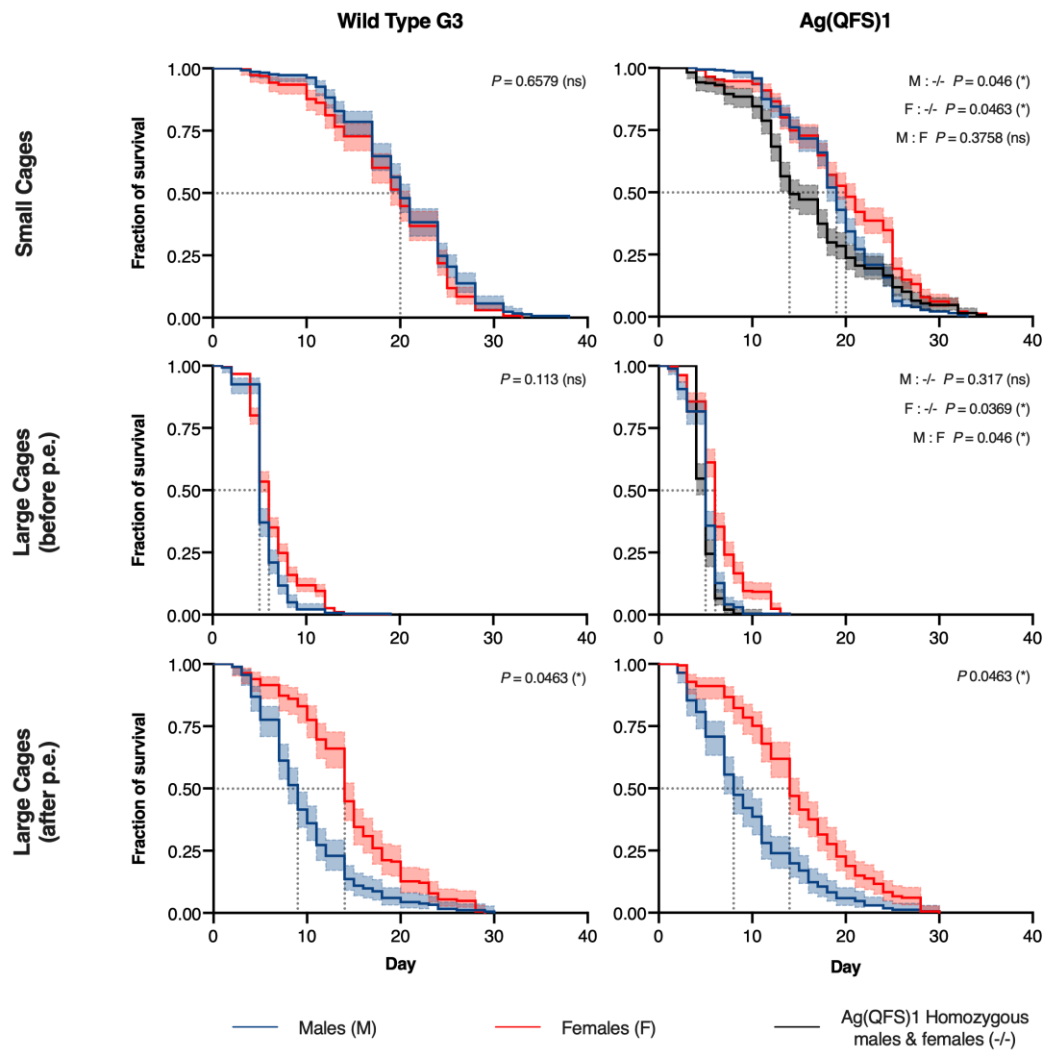
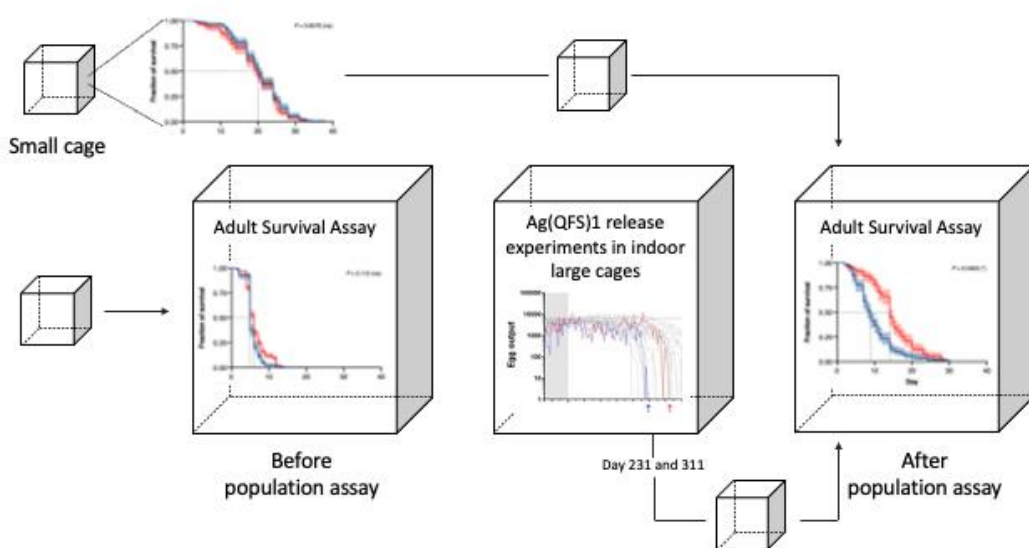

6 **cages.** a) Wild-type (left) and Ag(QFS)1 heterozygous (right) adults were monitored for both the male
7 (blue) and female (red) daily survival in small cages, and large cages assessed before and after the
8 population experiments (p.e.) (b). Ag(QFS)1 homozygotes males and females (black) were also
9 monitored in small cages (top, right) and large cages before the population experiments were
10 conducted (middle, right). Shading represents the 95% Confidence Intervals. The statistical
11 significance of the median survival (grey dotted lines) was determined using the Kruskal-Wallis
12 nonparametric test.
