

Identifying research questions regarding the effects of public health and social measures to prevent and control epidemics

Based on the input we have received, we have prioritised 22 of 178 epidemic interventions. In this survey, we would like to clarify what you believe are important questions about each intervention.

It can take time to respond to this survey. We ask you to formulate up to three research questions about the effects of each intervention that you think are important to answer in order to better inform future decisions. If you are unable to develop questions for all 22 interventions, please develop questions for the interventions that are most important to you.

Why is this survey important?

There are many questions that could be asked about each intervention. We need to clarify which questions are most important before apply criteria for prioritising the questions. We are using a James Lind Alliance Priority Setting Partnership (PSP) approach to do this.

The final list of prioritised questions will be used by CEIR to guide future research. In addition, we will publish the list in a scientific journal and share it with other researchers, research funders, and policymakers.

Do I have to write a research question?

No. Write as much or as little as you like. It is enough to write a short sentence about something that is important to you. We will treat all answers confidentially. We will not share your personal details with anyone and no one will know it is you who has sent in the questions.

For each type of intervention, please write your questions indicating the population, intervention, comparison, outcomes and setting you are most interested in (if possible). You will be able to submit up to 3 questions per intervention.

You do not have to submit a question for every intervention.

What happens next?

We will synthesize the questions that you and others send us, and then check the extent to which currently available research answers each question. We will than apply an agreed upon set of criteria to each question for which there is important uncertainty about the answer.
