 - ➔ Under what conditions would it make sense to you?
 - ➔ What would you wish for?
 - ➔ Under what conditions would you use/not use the system?
 - ➔ What are the limitations of monitoring symptoms and well-being and monitoring changes in general condition using the TEAM-X data ecosystem?
 - ➔ What concerns do you have?
4. **Narrative Impulse: What do you think is needed to ensure that the TEAM-X data ecosystem can be used and integrated well into healthcare in the long term?**
 - ➔ What skills are needed? For patients, relatives and caregivers?
 - ➔ Do they need specific training?
 - ➔ Are there any requirements from an organizational perspective?
 - ➔ What must be taken into account when developing the system?
 - ➔ What expectations and requirements do you have of the design?
