

Focus group discussion guide and protocol

Research project title: Changes and policy feedback effects of no-fault compensation system in Thailand

Duration: Approximately 90–120 minutes

Participants: Public health experts and healthcare administrators

1. Introduction (5-10 minutes)

- Welcome and participant introductions
- Clarification of the discussion objectives
- Overview of confidentiality and data use
- Consent to participate and record the session
- Opportunity for questions

2. Opening context (10 minutes)

<i>Domain</i>	<i>Key Questions</i>
<i>Background and Policy Intent</i>	What was your understanding of the objectives of the NFCS introduced during the COVID-19 vaccine rollout? How did the scheme originate and establish?

3. Exploring policy feedback (60-80 minutes)

<i>Domain</i>	<i>Key Questions</i>
<i>Administrative Effects</i>	What worked well in the implementation of the claims and compensation process? What bottlenecks were observed? Were frontline healthcare providers engaged or informed in the process?
<i>Fiscal Effects</i>	Was the scale of compensation fiscally manageable during the pandemic? Were there concerns about sustainability?
<i>Public Trust and Vaccine Confidence</i>	Did the NFCS impact vaccine uptake or acceptance in your view? Were there demographic groups (e.g., youth, informal workers, older persons) who remained sceptical despite the scheme?
<i>Communication and Engagement</i>	What were the most effective outreach strategies used by NHSO? What improvements are needed in public communication during future crises?

4. Future directions and reflections (15-20 minutes)

<i>Domain</i>	<i>Key Questions</i>
<i>Policy Learning</i>	What lessons can be drawn from Thailand's NFCS that other LMICs could adapt? Should similar compensation schemes be institutionalised for other public health emergencies?
<i>Institutional Capacity</i>	How can administrative and fiscal capacities be improved for better preparedness?
