| Population/<br>Participants | Perspectives of nurses with varying levels of professional qualification or nurses were actively involved as participants  | Other healthcare professionals alongside nurses and the data specific to nurses could not be extracted and analyzed separately  |
| Concept                     | Focus on roles and responsibilities of nurses in suicide prevention, including the specific context of requests for Medical Assistance in Dying (MaiD), assisted suicide, or euthanasia  | suicidality among nurses themselves<br>Focus on training or educational needs of nurses related to specific interventions or programs<br>Focus on the testing or evaluation of particular interventions, programs, or instruments |
| Context                     | Focus on adult care settings in an international context   | Non-care settings<br>Focus exclusively on suicide prevention among children or adolescents  |
| Types of evidence sources   | empirical studies – including qualitative, quantitative, mixed-method research, and case reports – published in peer-reviewed journals<br><br>reviews incorporating peer-reviewed empirical studies<br><br>guidelines, standards, policy papers, discussion papers, and professional codes | -   |
