TOPIC GUIDE FOR INTERVIEWS WITH STAKEHOLDERS (LINE MANAGERS, POLICY MAKERS...)

Explain purpose of interview – so that others in different settings can learn from their experience – important therefore to give their frank views, even if critical

1) What attracted you to engage with the GC implementation idea?

2) What kind of preparation do you feel you need? (if done later – looking back, what kind of preparation would you have wished to have)

3) What do you think will be a facilitator in the process of implementation?

- Examples: Context, HCP, service users, setting, model of care

4) What do you think will be a barrier/challenge in the process of implementation?

- Examples

PROMPT: How can we help to minimize this barrier?

PROMPT: What action could be taken to minimize this barrier?

5) How far do you feel the Group Care affects women's experiences of ANC/PNC?

7) Do you feel Group Care would work as part of normal ANC/PNC (as part of the national system)?

- PROMPT: Do you think there are opportunities to extend Group Care into the antenatal/postnatal period (ask as appropriate to what stage they offered)?
- Do you think there are any services or groups for whom it is not suitable?
