

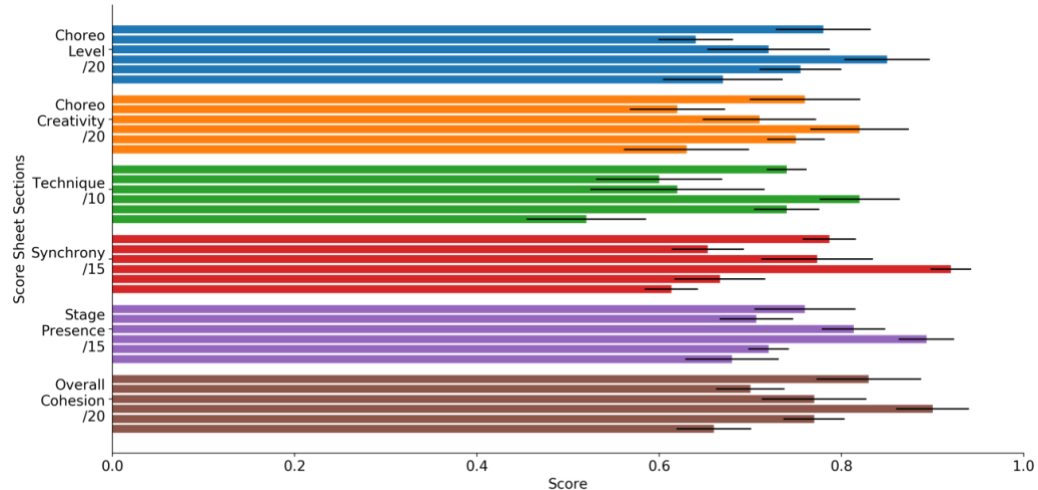

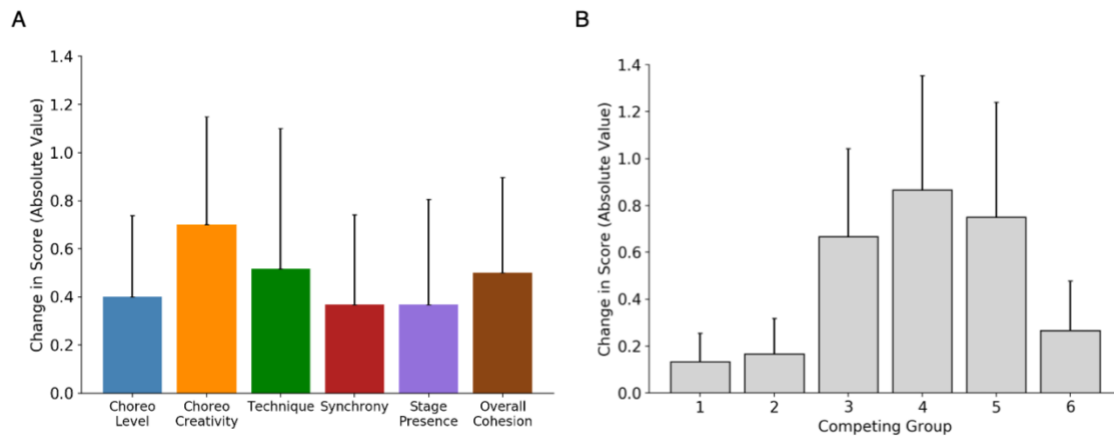
Breakdown of subsections of judges score sheet by competing group



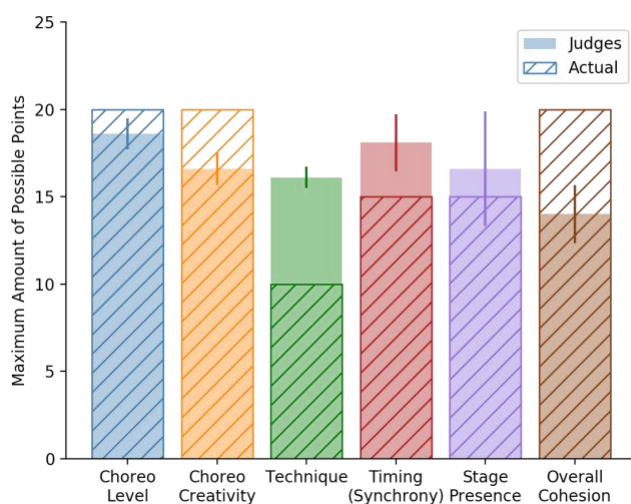

Within each subsection, each bar represents a competing group, with the highest bar on the y-axis corresponding to the first competing group.
