



Additional file 9: Absolute follow-up KOOS and EQ-5D scores. A) Total KOOS score and scores of the individual KOOS subcategories 6 months and **B)** 2 years postoperatively. No differences were found between patients with an isolated ACL rupture and patients with concurrent meniscal injury. **C)** EQ-5D sum score and the **D)** self-reported health score 2 years postoperatively.
