Notes:

1. **Free and Informed Consent Form:** Participants were presented with the consent form before accessing the questionnaire and proceeded to Section 1 only after accepting participation.
2. **Anonymity:** No identifying data (name, email, or other personal identifiers) were collected in the electronic form to ensure participant anonymity.
3. **Multiple-choice questions:** 17 questions with pre-defined response options
4. **Open-ended questions:** 10 questions allowing free text responses for qualitative analysis
5. **Data collection periods:** August 2024 (semester 2024.2) and February 2025 (semester 2025.1)
6. **Distribution method:** Survey link disseminated through faculty WhatsApp groups with weekly reminders over the collection period.
