

Interview Guide

Brief Introduction:

This interview guide was specifically developed for the purposes of the present study to explore the barriers factors involved in the rectification of issues identified during nursing quality supervision.

The guide employs a semi-structured format, focusing on six core thematic areas. The primary objective is to elicit detailed, in-depth narratives from participants regarding their experiences and perceptions. The open-ended questions are designed to allow participants to freely express their views, while the structured prompts ensure comprehensive coverage of key research domains related to internal, external, procedural, and measure-specific factors affecting rectification work.

Interviewers used this guide flexibly, probing for concrete examples ("Why?" and "Please provide examples") to ground the discussions in real-world instances and deepen the understanding of underlying reasons.
