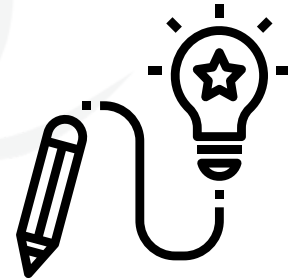

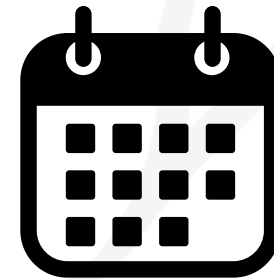

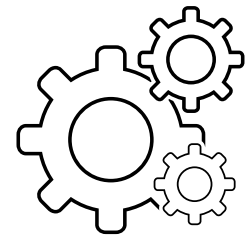

RESULTS

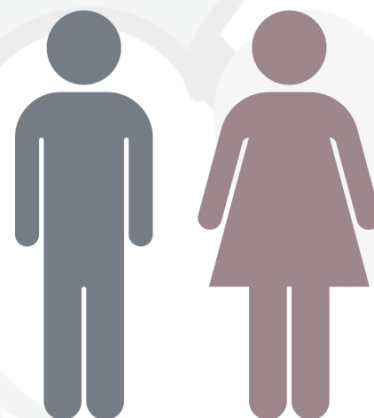
Effect of the Self-Compassion
