

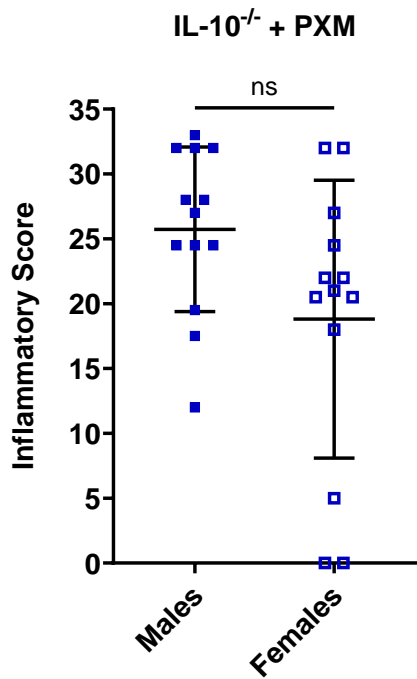
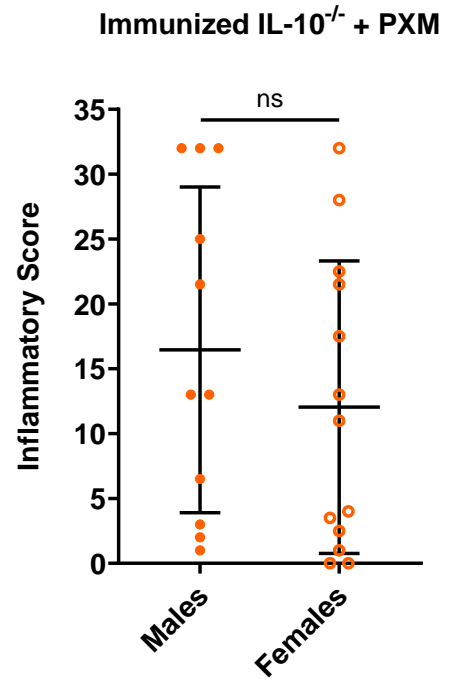

Horizontal line and error bars represent the mean inflammatory score \pm SD of each respective gender group. ns = not significant using unpaired two-tailed Welch's t test. n = 13 per group. **B** Inflammatory scores in male and female IL-10^{-/-} mice immunized with RELM β peptide and treated with PXM.
