- If your health continues to get worse in the future, where might you face challenges in managing your daily life?
- Which health services do you currently use? Have you experienced any challenges in accessing health services in the past? If so, what were they?

Future challenges:

- When you think about becoming sicker and more dependent on others, what fears and worries come to mind?

Support:

- What would help you in your current situation?
- Do you talk openly about dying and death? If so, with whom do you discuss these topics?

Wishes regarding care:

- What would you want in terms of care from others if you were seriously ill and in need of assistance?
- How should places and facilities be designed so that you feel comfortable there?
- How could the care of seriously ill homeless people be improved in the future?
