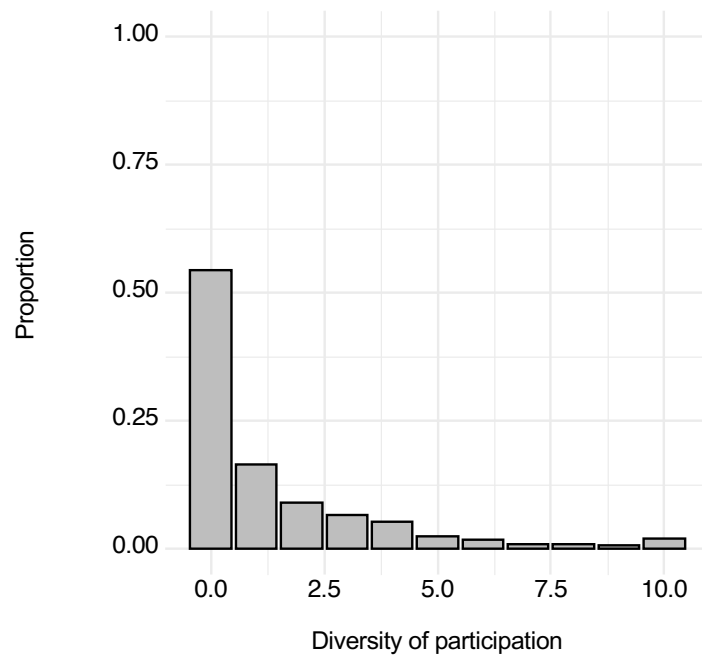

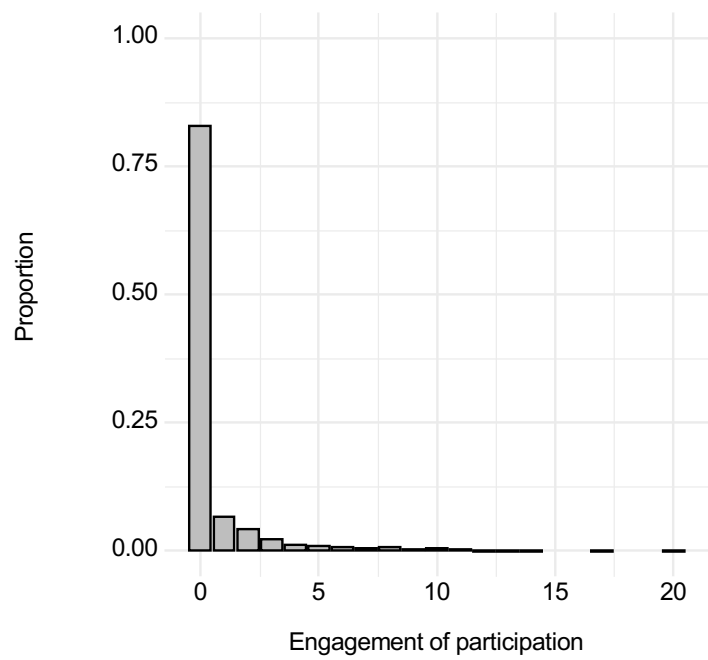

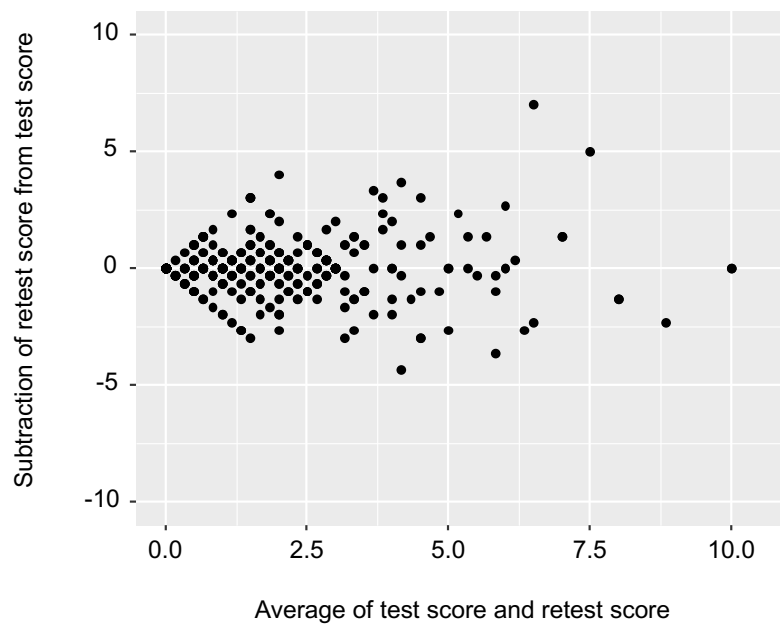


a. Diversity of participation

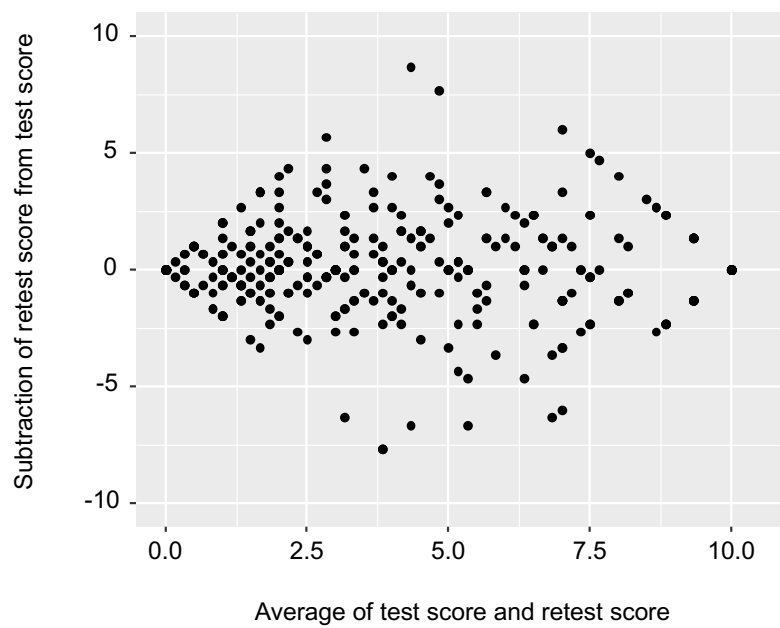


b. Engagement of participation
