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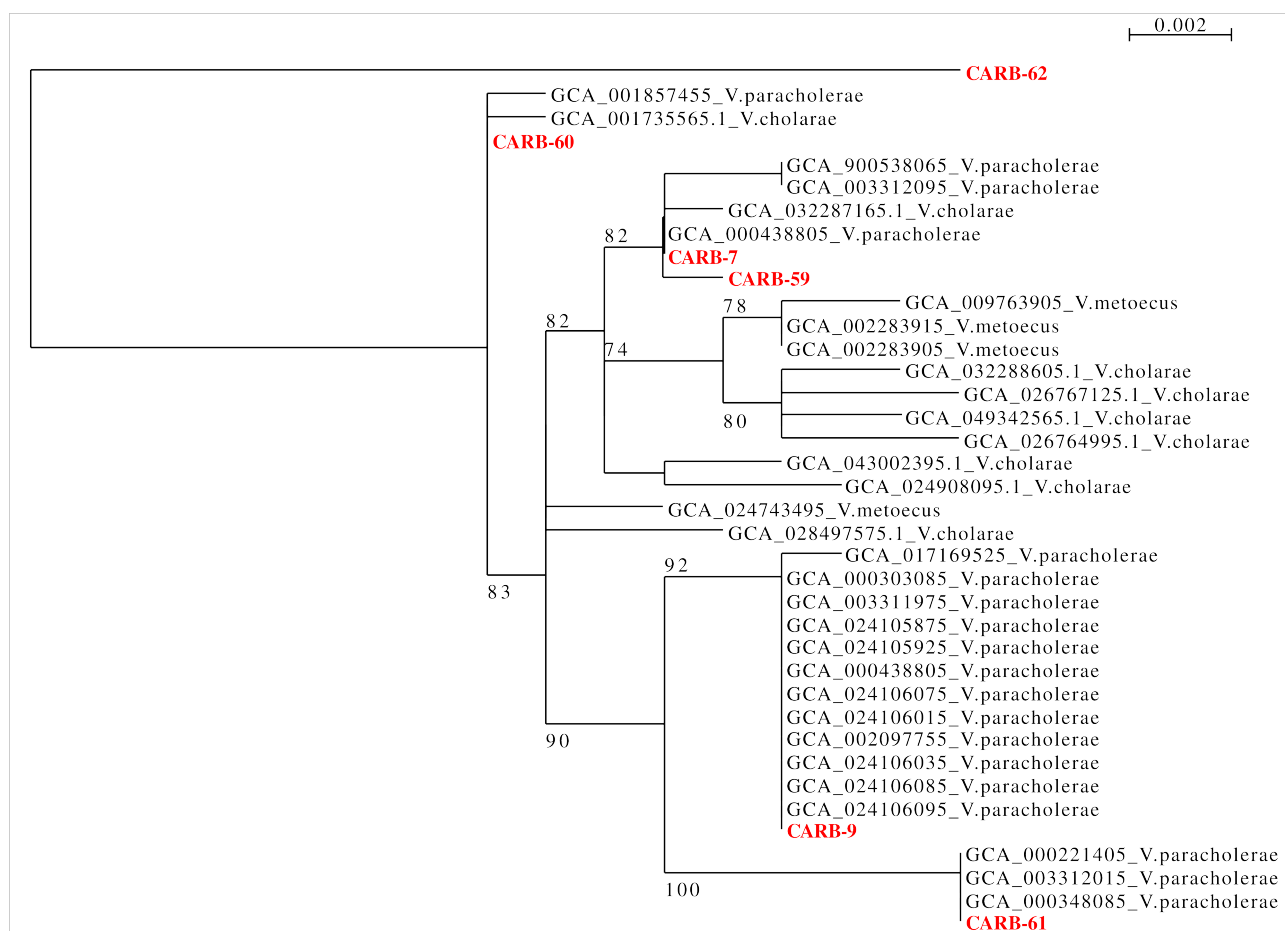


Figure 3A Maximum-likelihood phylogenetic tree of SI-associated *bla*_{CARB}. The reference sequences are colored in red.

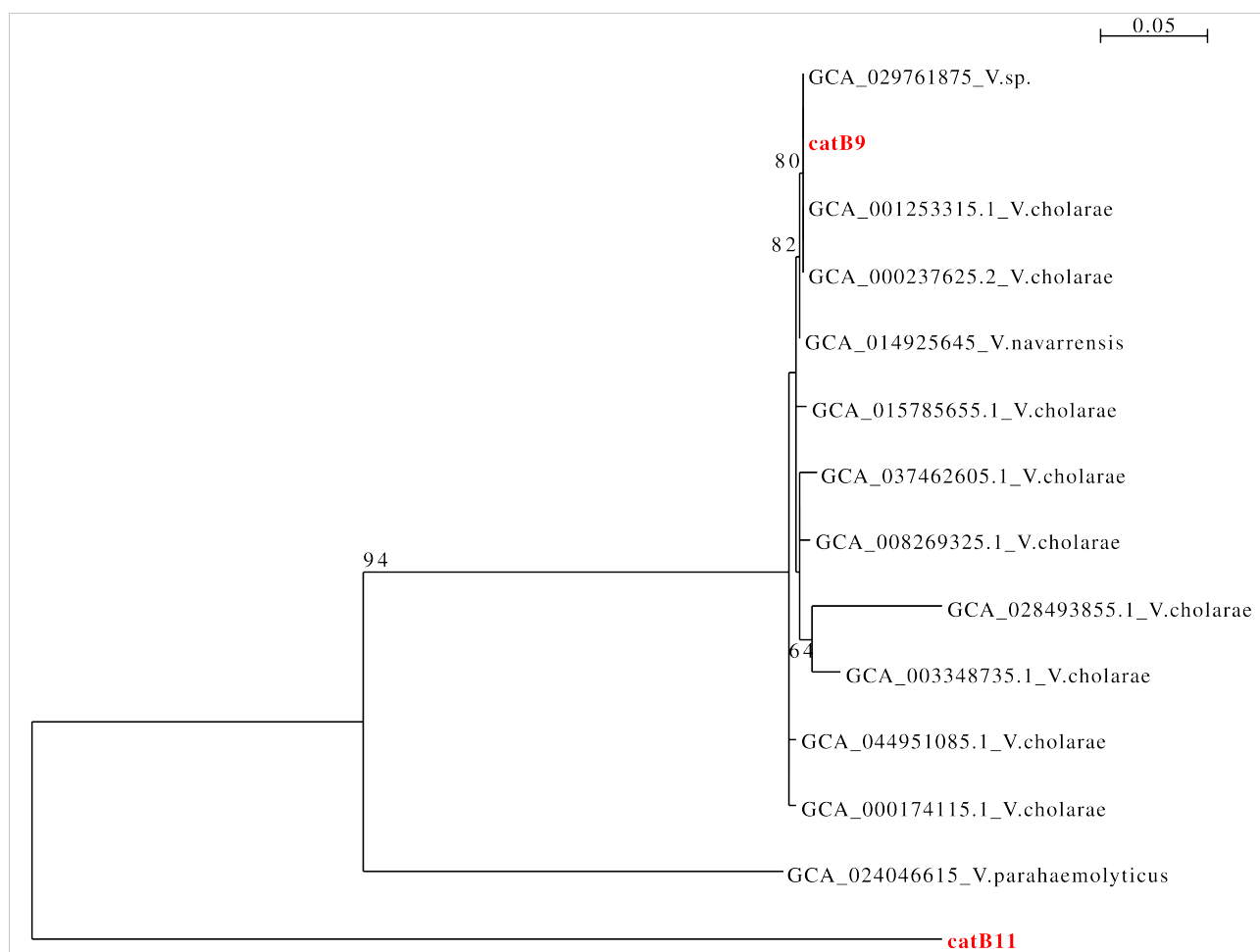


Figure 3B Maximum-likelihood phylogenetic tree of SI-associated *cat*. The reference sequences are colored in red.

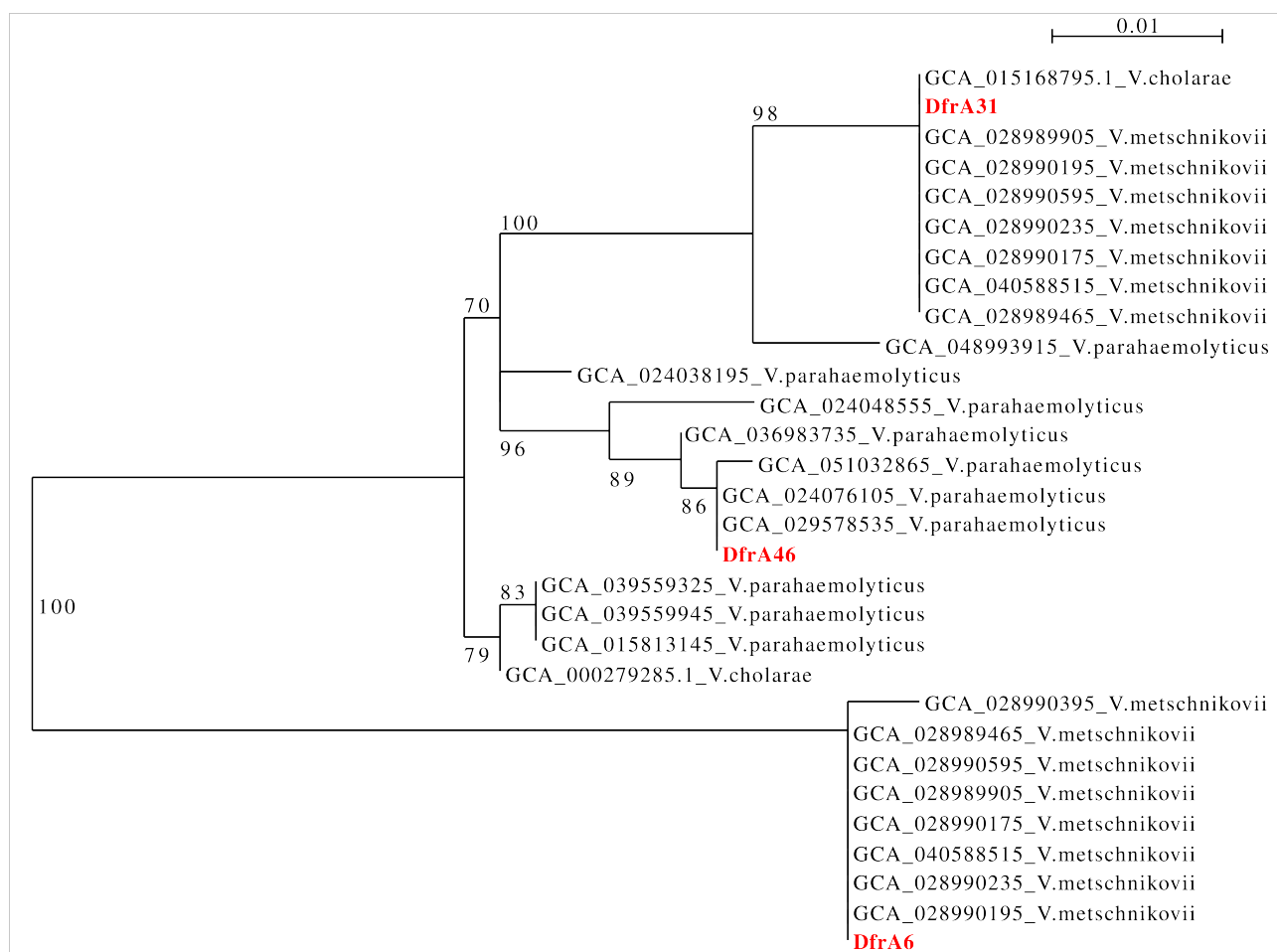


Figure 3C Maximum-likelihood phylogenetic tree of SI-associated *dfrA*. The reference sequences are colored in red.

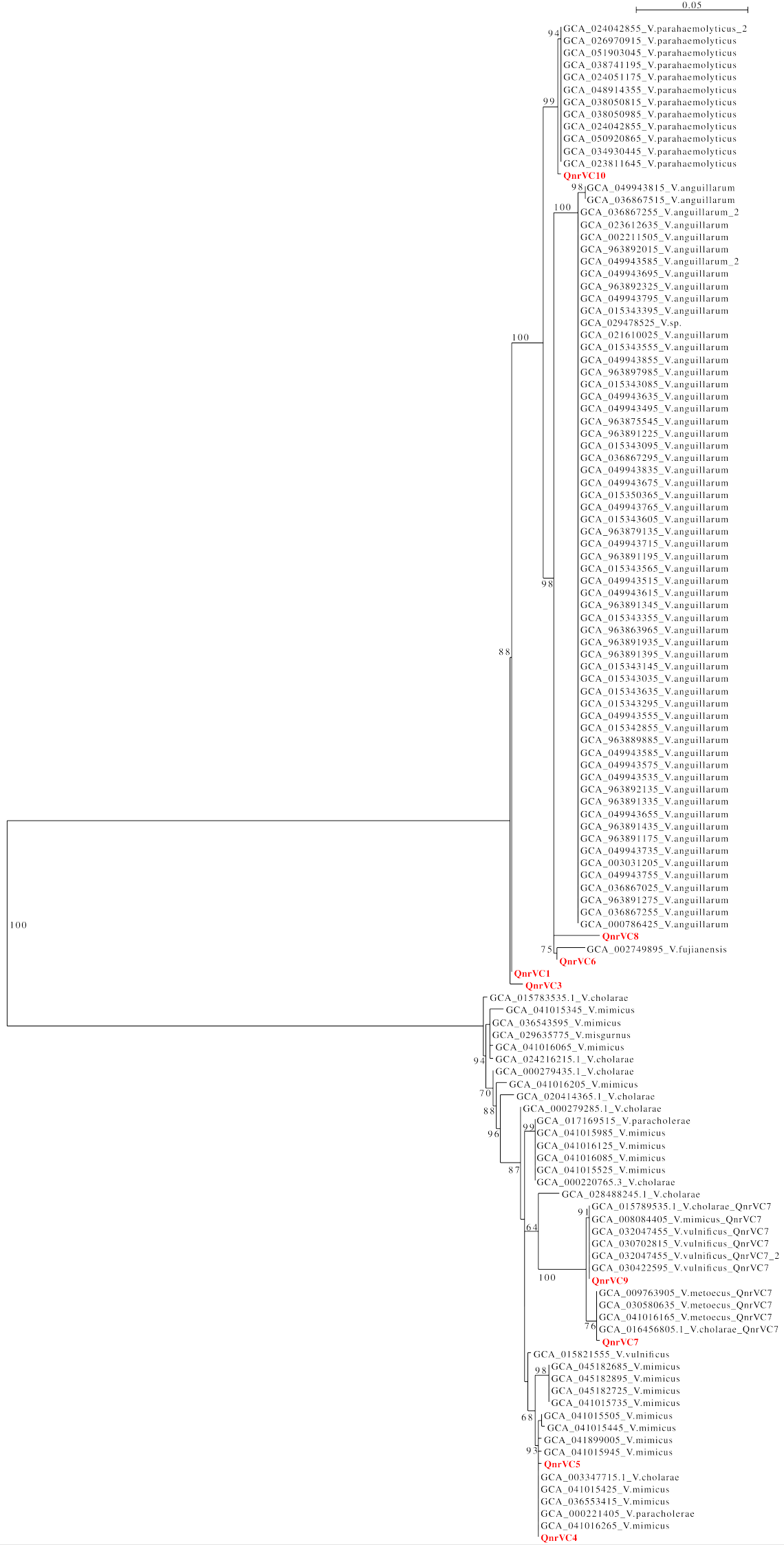


Figure 3D Maximum-likelihood phylogenetic tree of SI-associated *qnr*. The reference sequences are colored in red.

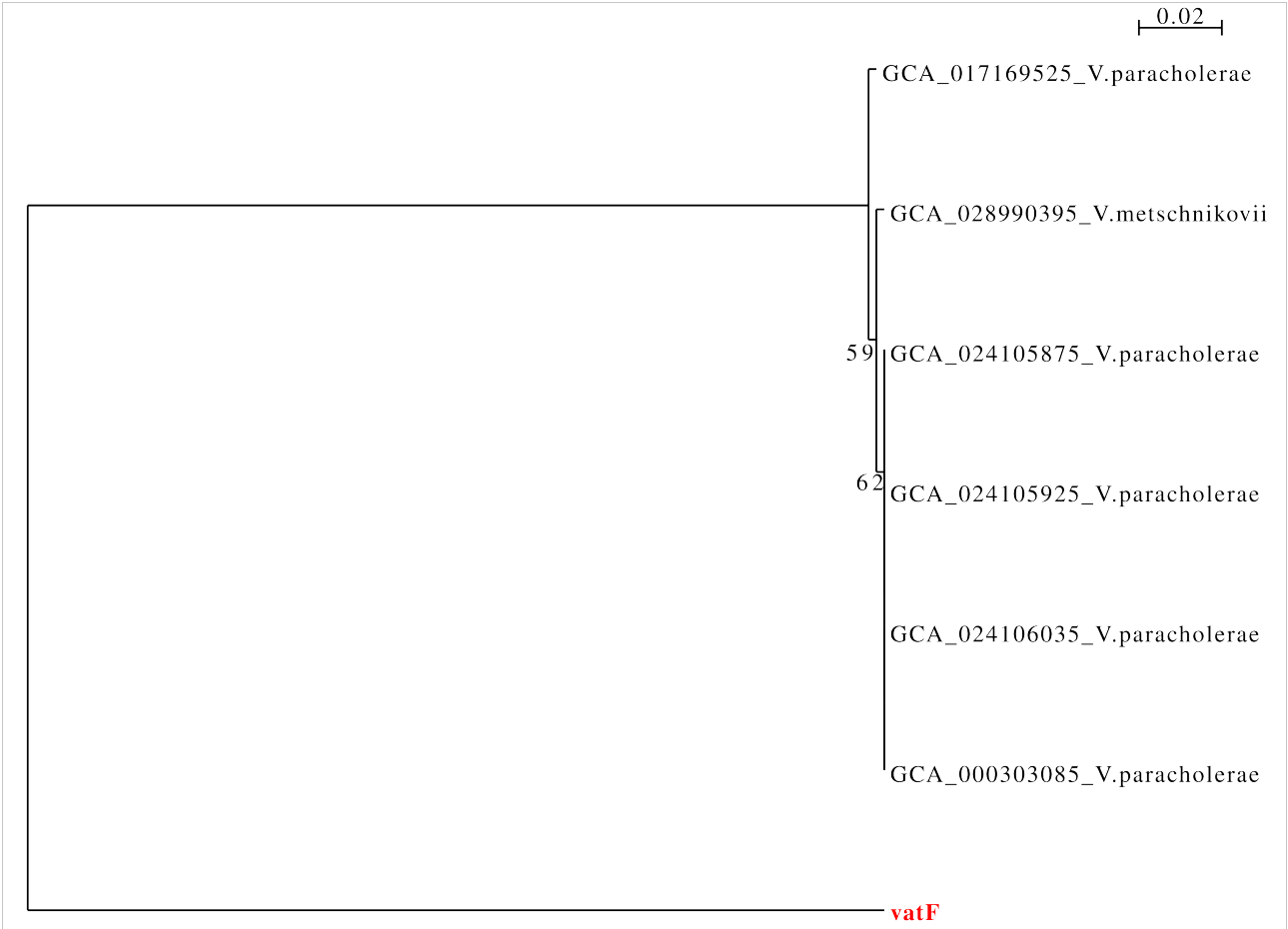


Figure 3E Maximum-likelihood phylogenetic tree of SI-associated *vat*. The reference sequence is colored in red.
